AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CONTINUED PARTICIPATION OF THE CITY OF BALLWIN, MISSOURI, IN THE MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL DRUG TASK FORCE ORGANIZED BY ST. LOUIS COUNTY.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Sections 70.210 – 70.320, inclusive, RSMo. 2000, as amended, political subdivisions, including the City of Ballwin, are empowered and authorized to contract and cooperate with other political subdivisions for a common service; and

WHEREAS, the County of St. Louis, Missouri, is a political subdivision and desires cooperation, from and by the Ballwin Police Department and the Ballwin Social Services Department, in carrying out the aims of that Multi-Jurisdictional Drug Task Force organized by St. Louis County, Missouri; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ballwin has been participating in the activities of such Multi-Jurisdictional Drug Task Force and has the ability and is willing to continue to participate in such Multi-Jurisdictional Drug Task Force.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF BALLWIN, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: There is hereby approved an agreement with the County of St. Louis, Missouri, for the continued participation by the City of Ballwin, Missouri, in the activities of the St. Louis County Multi-Jurisdictional Drug Task Force for a period of one year beginning on January 15, 2017 and ending on January 15, 2018, subject to the provisions of paragraph # 6 of the attached contract.

<u>Section 2:</u> The cost of participation shall be borne by each jurisdiction.

Section 3: The Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute appropriate documents to affect the purpose of this Ordinance.

<u>Section 4:</u> This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
