AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE III, SECTION 7-48 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BALLWIN WITH RESPECT TO THE ADOPTION OF THE 2014 EDITION OF THE INTERNATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE PERTAINING TO THE INSTALLATION OF ELECTRICAL WIRING AND APPARATUS, PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF ELECTRICAL PERMITS, FEES, AND RELATED INSPECTION REQUIREMENTS, AND INCLUDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF BALLWIN, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. **ADOPTION OF ELECTRICAL CODE**

That a certain document, three copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Ballwin, being marked and designated as the 2014 Edition of the International Electrical Code, as published by the National Fire Protection Association, be and is hereby adopted as the Electrical Code of the City of Ballwin, in the State of Missouri; for the installation of electrical wiring and apparatus, providing for the issuance of electrical permits, fees, and related inspection requirements and including penalties, conditions and terms of said Electrical Code are hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof, as is fully set out in this ordinance, with additions, insertions, deletions and changes, if any, prescribed in Section 2 of this ordinance.

Section 2. ADDITIONS, INSERTIONS, AND CHANGES

Article III, Section 7-48 (a) shall be amended by deleting the reference to the 2008 National Electrical Code and inserting the words "2014 International Electrical Code".

Section 3. **INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES REPEALED**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict repealed.

Section 4. SAVING CLAUSE

That nothing in this ordinance or in the Electrical Code hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding impending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes or action acquired or existing, under any act or ordinance hereby repealed as cited in Sections 2 and 3 of this ordinance; nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this ordinance.



Section 5. **DATE OF EFFECT**

That the City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance, and cause the same to be published as required by law; and this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval as required by law.

<u>Section 6.</u> This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

However, nothing in this section contained shall prevent the issuance of licenses to nonresidents of Missouri or foreign corporations for the privilege of selling to duly licensed wholesalers and soliciting orders for the sale of intoxicating liquors to, by or through a duly licensed wholesaler, within this state.

<u>Section 2.</u> This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
