RE: Construction Discount

Bob, construction is beginning on the installation of the new irrigation system at the golf course as well as the removal of existing sprinkler heads by city staff. We have been informed by the contractor that in addition to general disruption including workers on the course, one hole of the course will be shut down at a time in order to install the new system. This means for approximately two months, golfers will be able to only play eight holes instead of nine.

Staff is recommending a reduction in green fees of \$2 per round while construction is going on in order to help compensate for the inconvenience and keep players on the course. Rental cart rates will remain the same. Below would be our rates during construction.
