RE: Storm Repairs

As you are aware, the City of Ballwin experienced a relatively severe weather event several weeks ago involving hail and torrential rains. As a result of that event, several Ballwin facilities sustained damage including The Pointe, North Pointe, the Police and Court Center, and the Government Center.

A claim for the varied damage has been submitted to our insurance company. Due to the untimeliness of the storm relative to the opening of North Pointe on May 23, the insurance adjuster has visited the facility and agreed that the insurance company will reimburse the city in full the \$29,421 expense payable to Rockhill Mechanical for the replacement of the four pump motors and two electrical panels damaged beyond repair due to flooding involved with the storm.

Per your approval staff has proceeded with this work in order to have the pool ready for opening on May 23. Staff anticipates being able to solicit competitive pricing and formal approvals involved with the other damages.
