SUBJECT: HOLLOWAY CULVERT REHABILITATION - CONSTRUCTION TESTING

Material testing is required for federally funded projects. This cost is 80% federally reimbursable. The required tests are necessary to assure compliance with the specifications.

Because we are not qualified to perform these tests, proposals were requested from three firms. The proposals are summarized in the table below. One firm, Geotechnology responded that the project is too small and they would not be submitting a proposal.

Of these costs, 80% will be federally reimbursed. The remaining budget will be applied to in-house inspection which is also 80% reimbursable.

SCI Engineering provided satisfactory testing services for the Kehrs Mill Road project in 2012.

Recommendation: We recommend awarding the contract to SCI Engineering, Inc.
