preparing for several upcoming projects, which include street repairs and improvements, a new Police Station, and renovations to our beloved Ferris Park.

This year, we are continuing our focus on pavement and street repair to provide our residents and visitors with excellent street conditions. A list of our 2021 street improvement projects can be found on page 12. Additionally, we received two federal grants which will allow us to resurface Holloway Road in 2021 and a portion of New Ballwin Road in 2022.

In 2019, the City conducted a needs assessment for enhancements to our police station, including full ADA compliance, an improved ventilation system, and safer entry ways for our officers and visitors. We were in the preliminary design stages when the pandemic hit and the decision was made to halt this project due to revenue uncertainties. We are now moving forward with the design process and hope to break ground on a new facility in late 2021 or early 2022.

By the next issue, our Ferris Park project should be wrapping up or completed! Construction began last October and will lead to an expanded parking lot, redesigned recreation field, new trails and pathways, and an outdoor functional fitness structure. This renovation is just one of multiple parks improvements we plan to make over the next few years, as outlined in our Parks Master Plan.

Remembering **Ballwin's "Old Town"**



The present location of the "Olde Towne Plaza" is, indeed, the location of much of Ballwin's original "old town."

John Ball's home was located where Regions Bank now sits. Towne Plaza now covers the area that once included many of the buildings that were listed in the Ballwin Historical Commission's survey as being of "historic" significance,

Much of Ballwin's original town was located immediately across Manchester Road from John Ball's house. Olde primarily because most of them were constructed in the 1800s.

The Old Ballwin Schoolhouse, previously located where Lowes is now situated, was moved to its present location immediately east of Ballwin Elementary School.




Image: Ballwin Inventory of Historical Buildings




Image: Map of Old Town Ballwin

Waterford Annexation


We would like to welcome our newest residents to the City of Ballwin! During their October 26th meeting, the Board of Aldermen approved the annexation of Waterford subdivision to the City, effective January 1, 2021. Our new neighbors have joined our second ward, represented by Alderman Kevin M. Roach and Alderman Mark Stallmann.


This approval makes Waterford the first annexation into the City of Ballwin in the last 20 years. The subdivision is located approximately one half-mile south from Manchester Road on the eastern side of Reinke Road. It makes up the entirety of a lingering section of Unincorporated St. Louis County between the Cities of Ellisville and Ballwin, which stemmed from an annexation by Ballwin in 1999. The 1999 annexation included subdivisions like Oakwood Farms, Westbrooke Woods, Deer Creek, and others along the northern edge of Kiefer Creek.

This process began in early May 2020, when Waterford presented Ballwin with a petition containing more than 75% of the signatures of registered voters within their subdivision's boundaries. With this majority-support petition, we then were able to begin a Plan of Intent. This was presented before the St. Louis County's Boundary Commission for a Simplified Boundary Changes through a public hearing on July 22, 2020.

Following deliberation by the Boundary Commission, they voted in approval for the annexation on August 25, 2020, which was then formalized the following month. Given the small size of the annexed area, it was decided by St. Louis County that the approval was best accomplished internally through the Boundary Commission. The City allowed for the entire allotted time of three months to pass before bringing it forward to the Board of Aldermen for approval (Ordinance 20-23) on October 26, 2020.



Budge Ballwin 2021

I am pleased to present the City of Ballwin's 2021 Budget. The budget serves as the City's fiscal plan from January 1, 2021 - December 31, 2021. It includes our goals, objectives, and future financial projections. I've included graphs that show the City of Ballwin's projected revenues and expenditures. 
Total revenues equal \$20,993,895. Major revenue for the City of Ballwin include sales taxes, public utility licenses, and community programs. The City has \$0 property tax, so it's reliant on the categories included in the chart above.

SALES TAXES represent \$9.6 million or 45% of General and Capital Fund revenues. Ballwin consumers pay a sales tax rate of 8.738% of which .5% is for Capital Improvements and .5% is for Parks. An additional 1.0% is distributed from St. Louis County. These revenues are highly variable depending on economic conditions.

PUBLIC UTILITY LICENSES represent \$3.0 million or 14% of General and Capital Fund revenues. A gross receipts tax is paid by both public and private utility companies doing business in Ballwin for use of the public right-of-way and is based on operating revenues. These companies generally pass the tax on to their customers.



COMMUNITY PROGRAMS represent \$2.8 million or 13% of General and Capital Fund revenues. Memberships and fees from Ballwin's community center, golf course, and outdoor water park generate these revenues. Additional sources include special programs such as race events, community festivals, and facility rentals.



Total expenditures equal \$22,136,025. Police, Public Works, and Capital Improvements make up a significant portion of the City of Ballwin's 2021 Budget.

PUBLIC WORKS represents 26% of the General Fund and includes road resurfacing, sidewalk repairs, and snow and leaf removal. Trimming and removal of trees in the right-of-way is also performed; a second tree crew will operate in 2021.

CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS total \$2.3 million and represent all expenditures for the Capital Fund. Completion of Phase 2 of the redevelopment of Ferris Park, planning and design work for the new police building, and resurfacing of Holloway Road are all planned.

Last year, the City of Ballwin was presented with a Distinguished Budget Presentation Award from the Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA) for the 2020 budget. This is the fifth consecutive award for the City. This award certifies Ballwin's budget documents were of the highest quality and rated proficient in serving as: a policy document, a financial plan, an operations guide, and a communications device.

The City of Ballwin's budget document consists of its primary General Fund, a Capital Improvements Fund, and several minor funds such as a Sewer Lateral Fund, Special Allocations (TIF) Fund, TDD Fund, and a Federal Asset Seizure Fund. Every fall, each department drafts an estimate of projects and their expenses to present to the Board of Aldermen for consideration, which they then work to solidify and prioritize the remainder of the year.

POLICE represents 34% of the General Fund. Included is the replacement of three patrol vehicles and

Public Works

The City's 2021 Budget was presented to, and approved by, the Board of Aldermen on Monday, December 14. In the City's budget (see website) on page 121, you will find a list of all of Public Works' planned street and sidewalk improvement projects for 2021. The city is looking to invest a little over \$1 million into our streets, so our residents, community members, and visitors have safe roadways to travel on.

Slabs/Curb & Gutter improvements will be made to the following streets:

Hollyleaf Court Ballwin Commons Drive Hickory Tree Lane Hickory Tree Court Caravel Court Sheffield Court Oakwood Farms Lane Log Hill Lane

Maymont Drive Annondale Lane Hillbrook Drive Lakewood Lane Castle Ridge Drive Westglen Village Drive Alverston Court

Additionally, the department will complete milling and repaying projects on the following streets:

These projects are scheduled to begin during the department's construction season, which usually takes place in the summer when school lets out.



Holloway Road Resurfacing

The resurfacing of Holloway Road will occur in 2021 to address deteriorated pavement, curbs, and gutters. Enginnering for this project was completed in 2019 and 2020. Benefits include a smoother driving surface, the reduction of liability from tripping, and compliance with federal regulations. Total expense is budgeted at \$1,156,040, with federal reimbursement of 80% of the project expenses (the net cost to the City is \$231,208).



Recap: Leaf Season

Our 2020 curbside leaf collection program began on Monday, November 2, and ended on Wednesday, December 16. Crews were able to complete four rounds through the City. We were blessed with wonderful weather... and a whole lot of leaves!

During last year's collection season, our crews collected almost 18,000 cubic yards of leaves. This amounts to approximately 47,432,425.50 leaves and a weight of 2,635.13 tons. Pictures of the leaf pile in the Public Works' yard are shown below.



This was BY FAR the most leaves collected over the past 13 years. For reference, we collected 10,920 cubic yards in 2015, 10,560 cubic yards in 2016, 11,360 cubic yards in 2017, 10,120 cubic yards in 2018, and 9,400 cubic yards in 2019.

Here is the 2020 breakdown of cubic yards by ward:

> Ward One: 3,634.64 Ward Two: 5,147.59 Ward Three: 6,116.06 Ward Four: 2,692.50

Chief's Corner

For this Chief's Corner, I chose to write about relationship building. This is something we do every day in all aspects of our lives, whether we are thinking about it or not. In order to build and maintain strong relationships, whether it be personal or professional, effort needs to be made.

Driveway Safety



Every year, there are children who are hurt while they are around areas where vehicles are common, such as driveways and parking lots. While these are thankfully not the most common type of injury, the risk of these types of accidents increases as children are able to play outside more frequently. These types of incidents happen most commonly in and around driveways and other areas that are near your home. The most heartbreaking part of these types of incidents is that a loved one is usually behind the wheel when these tragic accidents occur. In order to help reduce the risk of being involved in an incident that could hurt a child, please take the following tips to heart:


- 1. Walk all the way around your parked car to check for children who might be playing before getting inside the car. This is especially important in your or a friend's driveway. Kids don't always pick the best places to play and during a family or friend get-together, they will often seek odd spots to sit and play.
- 2. Designate a safe spot for children to wait when cars are entering and leaving a driveway. Ensure this is a spot where the driver of the vehicle can see the children clearly.
- 3. Accompany young children when they enter and exit a vehicle. Hold their hand while walking in driveways and parking lots or on nearby sidewalks.

Making these simple steps a part of your routine can have a big impact on reducing the chances of a tragedy.

The police department has been talking about the #9PMRoutine for a while now, especially with increases in thefts from unlocked vehicles. #9PMRoutine is a social media hashtag campaign to remind you to remove valuables from your vehicle, lock your car, and to close the garage door. When life gets hectic or when something in your normal routine is different, it is easy to forget to lock up or accidentally leave something of value in an unsecured vehicle. The St. Louis region has seen many vehicles entered unlawfully, and with the prevalence of residential surveillance cameras, we are seeing how fast cars are able to be checked by thieves and how fast those items disappear when an unlocked
