RECOMMENDATION: Award the 2015 Ammunition order under the Cooperative Procurement Agreement within the Missouri State Ammunition Contract, resulting from the State's competitive RFP process for the contract periods of October 29, 2014 through October 30, 2015. The State of Missouri Notification of Statewide Contract for Federal Ammunition was awarded to Gulf States Distributors, the sole authorized distributor for law enforcement of Federal Cartridge Company in this region.

Recommendation is under budget for this portion of the ammunition budget by \$489.00 due to the State Contract price coming in below the budget estimate provided by the distributor. The order will be placed contingent upon Board approval.

EXPLANATION: Ammunition is used for training, bi-annual qualification of officers for firearms assigned to them and/or personally owned off-duty firearms authorized by department policy, and issuing of replacement duty ammunition. Use of Force incidents carry the highest liability risk next to motor vehicle operations requiring the highest level of training and qualification standards. Extensive testing by the Firearms Training Unit has proven the Federal Cartridge Company produces a product that is superior in accuracy, reliability and quality control. Retail businesses have been contacted and are unable to meet the Missouri State bid price, nor can guarantee availability or quantity. Less-Lethal munitions are not included with this consent request.
