Preparations for summer are in full swing. Our staff, elected officials, and residents are all beginning to feel the excitement that comes with the start of this season. The tee times on our golf course are starting to fill up, the countdown to North Pointe's opening is officially underway, and excitement for the end of the school year is building. As we begin to usher in the new summer season, I'd like to reflect on the continued, refreshing growth our city experienced over the past few months.

In April, City operations moved to a new location in Vlasik Park with the completion of our new Government Center. I'd like to personally thank everyone who attended our grand-opening ceremony. If you haven't had a chance to tour the facility, I highly encourage you to do so.

In March, we announced Interim City Administrator Bob Kuntz would be named City Administrator through May 2020. This will allow the Board of Aldermen and me to allocate more time towards the comprehensive selection and hiring process for that position. City Administrator Kuntz's extensive tenure with the City will prove to be an asset as we navigate the future of our city, especially in light of some of the discussions happening at the county and regional level.

As most of you are aware, there is a proposal under consideration to merge St. Louis City and St. Louis County. This plan would impact all municipalities, including Ballwin, through the creation of a megacity. Your Board of Aldermen has gone on record to officially oppose such a plan.



The people and services provided by our great City are what make living in Ballwin so wonderful. The police presence and protection we enjoy, the street maintenance and public safety we may often take for granted, and the local representation that ensures your opinion matters are all extremely important to me. I want to personally ensure every resident has the opportunity to learn more about the plan and get involved in the process. 2019 Ballwin Election Results

The City of Ballwin has a new face on its Board of Aldermen.

Mike Utt (pictured) is the City's newest Ward 1 Alderman after winning the April 2 election in a three-way race. The position was previously held by Jimmy Terbrock, who served as Ward 1 Alderman for 14 years. The election also resulted in a win for incumbent Ross Bullington, who will continue to serve as one of the Aldermen for Ward 4. Mayor Tim Pogue, Ward 2 Alderman Mark Stallmann, and Ward 3 Alderman Jim Leahy ran unopposed. All five individuals were sworn in at the City's Board of Aldermen meeting on April 22.

JJ Kokesh Plumbing Celebrates 125 Years in Business

CUSTOMER SERVICE HAS CHANGED.

Technology has changed. The way business is done has changed. So when a company is able to adapt to all those changes while still remaining true to its values you get a really special combination.

JJ Kokesh is a company that has done just that. “Times have definitely changed, but knowing that our intent is always to give the best service to our customers and treat people how we want to be treated hasn’t changed. This mentality affects all our decisions as a company. That’s the wonderful thing about being a small company, you can choose to do the right thing,” said Office Manager Megan Kokesh.

Four generations ago, Jerry Joseph Kokesh came to St. Louis in pursuit of the American dream. His first plumbing job was installing a hand cranked pitcher pump, which he charged \$10 for. He had yet to turn 18.

Since indoor plumbing had yet to fully hit Ballwin in the early 1900’s Jerry grew his plumbing business while also working as a furnace installer, inventor, and tin smith (he even installed the original tin roof on the barn at Lucerne). But most notably, he started a legacy that has now been passed down to the fourth generation.

As the family business grew and focused solely on plumbing, each generation chose to stay and raise their families in Ballwin. Jerry and Josephine passed the business on to their son Ed and his wife Helen upon Ed’s return from serving in the Navy in WWII. Their son Lawrence married his wife Charleen, joined the Army, and when he came home in 1957 began working for the family business, becoming the third generation to run JJ Kokesh and Son in 1967. In 2014, their son Joe and his wife Megan, continued the family tradition that began four generations before.

The Kokesh’s have always valued being part of the Ballwin community. Lawrence and his son JR started the first

Ballwin Days fun run, and Ed and Helen were delighted to be crowned Ballwin Days King and Queen in 1986.

Perhaps the biggest change to the business is the amount of change in technology. Things are obviously quite different from that first hand-cranked faucet, but what is special about that first job is how many people can still relate to it.

“From time to time we hear from customers who remember us working in their grandparents’ or great

grandparents' home doing jobs just like that. Knowing that you had an impact, and that your business was there 100+ years ago is very special. And now we get to serve those same people who remember us from decades ago in a totally different way," said Megan.

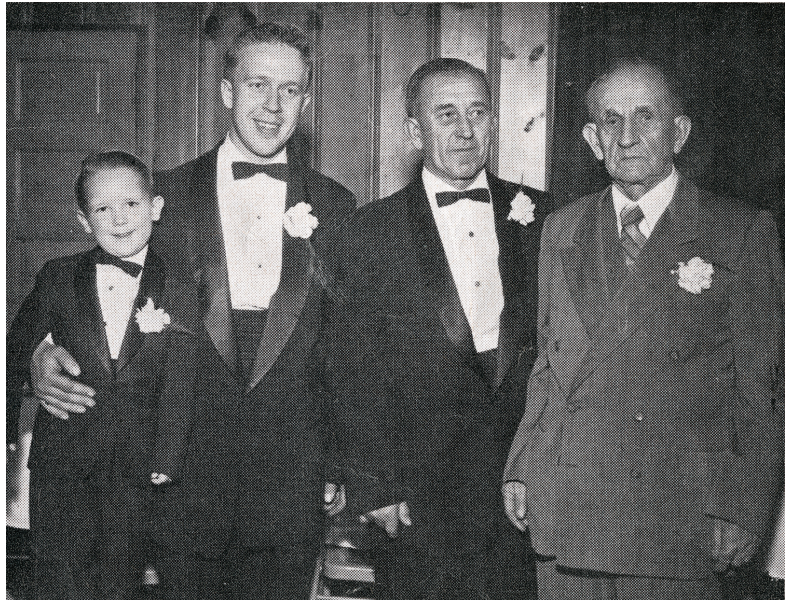

See a problem? Let us know!

This is the time of year when all kinds of issues pop up around Ballwin. The change in temperature and spring storms can strain the infrastructure we rely on. This article will break down how to report two of the most common issues this time of year: potholes and street light outages.

Reporting Potholes

Our Public Works Department has been working to fill potholes since the weather first started to warm up, but the success of the program depends heavily on YOU.

We need the extra eyes out on the road every day to tell us where the problem areas are in our city. Residents are encouraged to contact the Public Works Department to report potholes. The best way to do this is to go to our website at www.ballwin.mo.us and click on the yellow “Report an Issue” button, then click on the “Report a Pothole” button and fill in the information.

Using this format will ensure the request is added directly to our ongoing service request list. Ballwin’s Public Works team will then work to get the problem fixed as soon as possible.



Ballwin is always keeping an eye out for potholes and other street maintenance issues, but with hundreds of miles of street lanes to maintain it's quite possible for some to slip through the cracks (no pun intended).

If you're not on the internet or prefer to call to report the pothole you may do so by calling 636-227-9000 and selecting option #2 to reach the Public Works Department. If we're in the field and unable to answer, simply leave a message with the details and location of the problem and we'll take care of it right away.

We are entering the busy construction period so please remember to slow down and move over when you see our crews and equipment out on the streets. Please do your part and keep our crews safe throughout the season.



Reporting Street Light Outages

A common misconception in Ballwin is that the City maintains the street lights in town.

When a spring storm results in a power outage or when you notice a street light needs maintenance, many residents think the Public Works Department responds to these inquiries. Ballwin is happy to direct your call, but reports need to be made directly to Ameren.

You can call Ameren 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, at 1-800-552-7583. Street lights are repaired within 10-14 business days. Please be sure to include the address or location of the light pole and the street light tag and/or street light number (pictured). Providing this information reduces the response time for Ameren.

Parenting and Social Media

It doesn't seem that long ago that parents were worried about their kid getting hurt playing outside or if they were going to make it home before the street lights kicked on. In today's world, it seems as if the list of worries is exponentially longer for parents.

One of the top items on every parent's list is the internet and whatever device your child is using to access the internet. We are often asked how can we as parents make sure our kids are safe? There is no one clear answer to this question. The truth of the matter is kids are smart and find ways to hide what they are doing from their parents. This doesn't mean that there is nothing that can be done.

The first step in the process for parents is to set clear boundaries for what is acceptable and what is an inappropriate use of the internet. This will vary for every child and could potentially change as the child

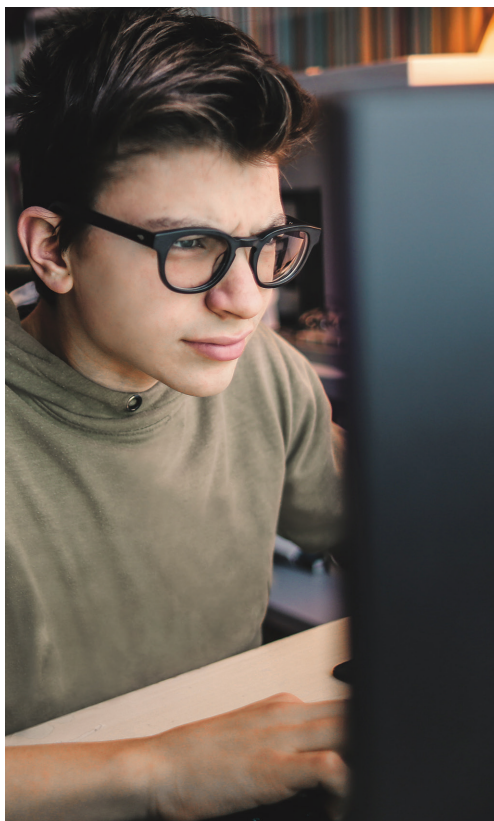
matures. These boundaries are important because it draws the line in the sand and provides the child with the information they need to comply with the rules. The important part of this step is to return to the conversation often to ensure you and your child have the same understanding of the rules.

The second step for parents is to be aware of what your children are doing on their devices. What websites are they visiting? Who are they talking to or texting? What apps are they using? These are the 3 main questions to ask yourself. Many apps, including games, have the ability to send direct or private

messages between users. This messaging feature is a popular way for messages to be hidden from the normal messaging functions of a device.

No situation is the same and not every child will be attempting to hide what they are doing. The list of how these functions work and what platform is popular today may change in an instant. POPULAR SMARTPHONE APPLICATIONS



SNAPCHAT

One of the most popular social networking apps on the market. The app is built around the idea that the user can take a photo/video and it will disappear. However, "stories" allow for users to view content for longer periods of time. A location tracking feature is also available in Snapchat.

INSTAGRAM

Instagram is one of the most popular photo and video sharing applications on the market. Users can snap, edit, and share photos and short videos to the public or their private network of followers. A direct message feature is available. Fake accounts are easily created to hide from parents.





TIK TOK

Tik Tok is a popular video sharing app. Live video streaming is available through the application. Tik Tok has been compared to the platform Chatroulette.

WHATSAPP

WhatsApp allows users to send text messages, audio messages, videos, and photos to one person or to a group of people. Much like the logo implies, the app provides many features that are native on a smartphone over a wifi connection.





WHISPER

Whisper is an anonymous social network that allows for users to share secrets with strangers. This is accomplished by placing text over a photo. Users can then communicate with one another publicly or privately in the app.

VAULT APPS

Vault applications are ones that appear to be a stock or standard applications. Some even have a standard function when opening, but hold a secret section that can store photos, videos, and or files, which are generally password protected.

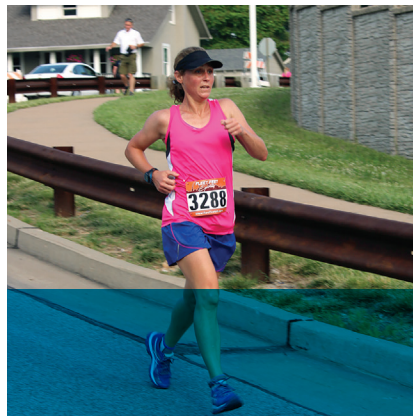

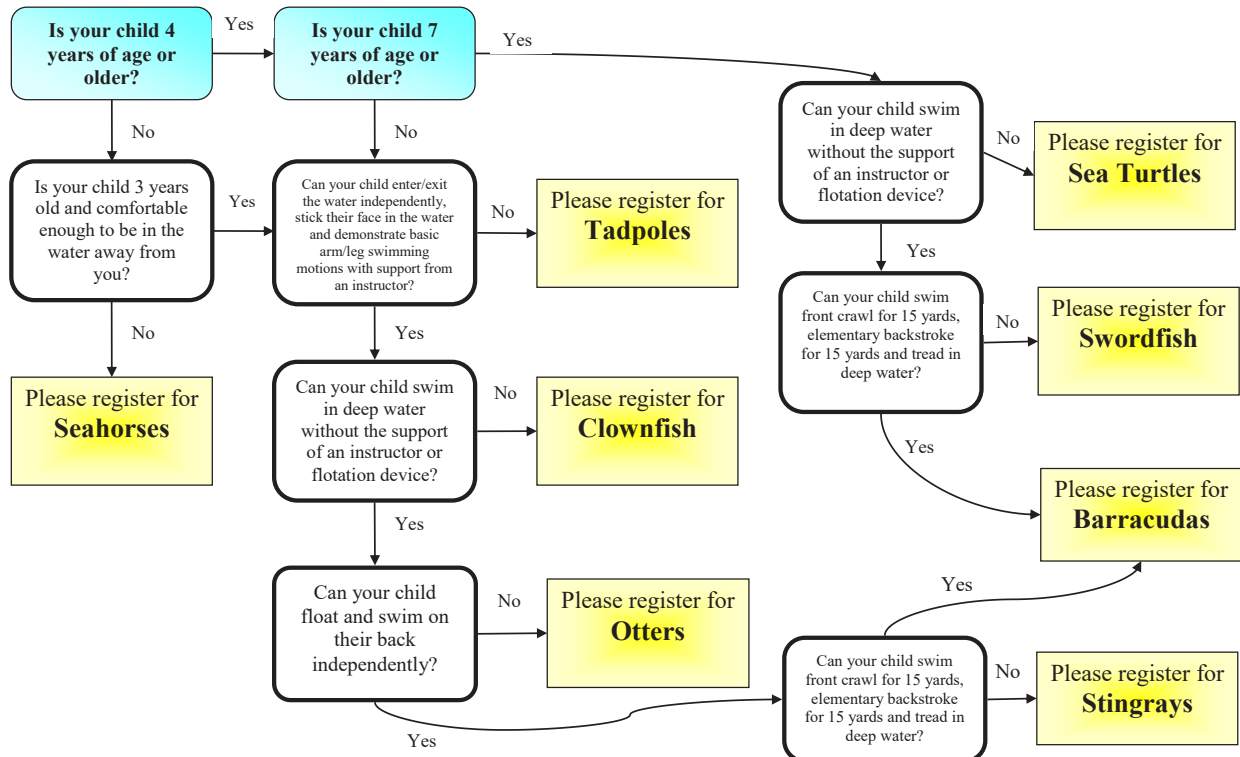

I need to send my camper with a sack lunch? Yes, please send your camper with a non-perishable lunch daily including a drink. Remember it can be hot at camp, so package it appropriately. Please do not send anything packaged in glass.

How will I know what group my camper is in?

We will be dividing groups by age: 5-6, 7-8, 9-10 and 11-13. Signs will be displayed at check-in to direct campers to their age-specific group.

What is the camper to counselor ratio?

To ensure all children are properly supervised we maintain a camper to counselor ratio of 6:1 for Camp Little Feet and 10:1 for all other camps.
