

RE: NO PARKING ORDINANCE

Traffic calming islands were installed on Meadowbrook Country Club Estates Drive and Meadowbrook Country Club Way within The Villas at Meadowbrook subdivision. To avoid conflicts between parked vehicles and motorist no parking signs were installed by the subdivision developer. With that in mind, an ordinance prohibiting parking within 50 feet of traffic islands is required. Attached is a map showing the locations of these islands.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SCHEDULE G OF SECTION 15-482 REGARDING NO PARKING AREAS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF BALLWIN, MISSOURI

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen has recognized certain areas within the City of Ballwin that create safety issues regarding parking and conflict with traffic; and

WHEREAS, no parking areas are set forth in Section 15-482 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ballwin and schedule G contained in Article XII thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF BALLWIN, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Section 15-482, Article XII, Schedule G of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ballwin shall be amended by adding the following:

Meadowbrook Country Club Estates Drive and Meadowbrook Country Club Way within 50 feet of the installed traffic islands.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
