Subject: 2017 Police Vehicle Purchase – RFP 17-21

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Sir,

The RFP opening for three 2017 Ford Utility Police Interceptor vehicles was conducted on Thursday, March 2<sup>nd</sup> at 10:00AM. Once the advertisement was published, I sent electronic RFP packets to Bommarito Ford, Fusz Ford, Machens Ford, Beuckman Ford and Sinclair Ford. I did not receive any other requests for RFP packets. By the March 2<sup>nd</sup>, 10:00AM deadline, I had received only two back, Fusz and Machens. Sinclair sent one, but it did not arrive until about 11:00AM on March 3<sup>rd</sup> and therefore was disqualified. The Sinclair bid came in as the highest regardless if it was submitted on time.

The formal results of the RFP opening are:

1. Fusz Ford: unit price - \$28,308.00      total cost - \$84,924.00
2. Machens Ford: unit price - \$28,497.00      total cost - \$85,491.00

Fusz Ford submitted the lowest bid however it came in \$1,824.00 over what was budgeted. When I explained while they were low bid it was over what we budgeted, Tom, Biehle, the Fleet Manager for Lou Fusz stated our in-house mechanic could equip the vehicles with emergency lighting for less than what the manufacturer package would cost and if we deleted the "Rear Lighting Solution" package they could meet our budget of \$83,100.00. Also, Fusz advised they have at least two of the vehicles in stock and expect more to arrive shortly, which will reduce the delivery time significantly. We purchased the 2016 Ford police vehicles from Fusz Ford and there were no issues with the transaction.

My recommendation is to purchase the vehicles from Fusz Ford.



Bidders must identify the bid number on the front of the envelope. If you do not care to bid, please return bid sheet(s) and note your reason.
2. Identify the item you will furnish by brand or manufacturer’s name and model numbers. Also furnish specifications and descriptive literature.
3. Whenever products or materials of any particular producer or manufacturer are mentioned in our specifications, such product or material is intended to be descriptive of type or quality and not restrictive to those mentioned.
