

CONSENT ITEM

RE: ASPHALT MILLING

DEPARTMENT: PUBLIC WORKS

PROGRAM: STREETS AND SIDEWALKS

RECOMMENDATION: We recommend awarding this contract to the low bidder, GS Grinding Services

EXPLANATION: For many years we have contracted for the asphalt milling and repaving of streets. With the purchase of an asphalt paver in 2017, the repaving/resurfacing work is budgeted in 2018 to be completed in-house.

Request for bid notices were sent to three contractors and advertised in the St. Louis Business Journal, Construction Market Data, Dodge Data & Analytics, and on the City's website.

The table below summarizes the bids received on February 23, 2018.
