AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PROVISIONS RELATING TO SOLICITING, PEDDLING OR HAWKING IN THE CITY OF BALLWIN.

WHEREAS, The Board of Aldermen has considered restrictions upon soliciting, peddling and hawking in the City of Ballwin and determined that amending the current code sections to accommodate the protected interests of the solicitors while protecting the public safety and private property of the residents can be accomplished by enacting certain reasonable time, place and manner restrictions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF BALLWIN, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 14-4 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ballwin shall be repealed in its entirety and replaced with the following:

SECTION 14-4: INVESTIGATION OF APPLICANT

During the period of time following the application for a license to solicit, the Chief of Police shall supervise an investigation as to the truth and accuracy of the information contained on the application as required in Section 14-3 herein to determine whether or not the applicant is entitled to the license as herein above stated. The Chief of Police may require the applicant to obtain a Missouri State Highway Patrol criminal history records check. If the Chief of Police has not completed his/her investigation within seven (7) business days, the license will nonetheless be issued by the City, subject however, to revocation upon completion of such investigation. Such a revocation may be implemented without hearing and shall have the same effect as a denial.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
