AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO POLICE SERVICE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, Winchester and Ballwin each approved and subsequently executed a Police Service Agreement dated June 17, 2019 ("Agreement") which provided that Ballwin was to take over from St. Louis County the provision of police services to Winchester beginning January 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, St. Louis County and Ballwin are willing to transition Winchester's police services effective October 1, 2019 rather than January 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Ballwin and Winchester have agreed that Ballwin shall commence providing police services to Winchester on October 1, 2019 according to the terms of an Amendment to the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF BALLWIN, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Amendment to Police Service Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A is approved and the Mayor and City Administrator of the City of Ballwin are authorized to execute the same on behalf of the City of Ballwin.

<u>Section 2.</u> This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
