Public Works FAQs

Got questions? We have answers! Below, you'll find answers to some of the most common questions our department receives. Most information about our department can be found on the website, but if there's something specific you want to know - just ask us! You can contact our department at pw@ballwin.mo.us or (636) 227-9000 (option 2).

Q: The streetlight near my house is not working properly. Who do I contact? A: The City does not handle streetlight outages. AmerenUE is contracted by the City to maintain streetlights. You can contact AmerenUE at (314) 342-1000.

Q: Where can I find information on major road projects happening in the city? A: On our website, you can find dedicated project pages on our upcoming major street projects, including our 2021 Holloway Road Resurfacing Project and 2022 New Ballwin Road Resurfacing Project. These can be found in the Public Works Projects section on our website.

Q: I live in a condo in Ballwin, why do I not receive leaf pickup? A: Our annual leaf collection service is provided exclusively for customers of the City's

contracted waste hauler, Republic Services, per our contract. For that reason, leaves are not collected from any multi-family units such as condominiums, apartments, or villas.



A: Once you submit a request for service, we dispatch a supervisor to assess the issue and will create a work order if appropriate. Unfortunately, we are never able to give an estimated start or completion date for work orders, as there are a variety of factors at play including weather, severity, manpower, equipment, etc.

Chief's Corner



Within the Ballwin Police Department, we have a number of different divisions and units. Our largest unit is the Patrol Division. Those are the uniformed officers you see every day patrolling your streets, and who are usually the first law enforcement officers on the scene of police calls. Another unit, and the focus of this article, is the Division of Criminal Investigation (DCI), a.k.a. the Detective Bureau.

The Ballwin Police Department's DCI is comprised of a Sergeant and four Detectives. These officers begin their careers as Patrol Officers for a number of years, and then can request

assignment to the DCI when an opening exists. Their job is to gather facts and evidence in criminal cases that go beyond the scope of the job of a Patrol Officer.

The cases they investigate come from three main sources. The first, and most common, are cases referred to them from the Patrol Division. If a case can be handled within a couple hours, the Patrol Officer will generally work that case to completion. Cases wherein a suspect has yet to be identified, or the case will take an extensive number of hours to work, are forwarded to the DCI.

The second source of cases for our detectives are referrals from other agencies. It is not unusual for another police department, or even a federal law enforcement agency, to pass their investigation on to our detectives when they find that their case has some type of link to the City of Ballwin. Our detectives will either take over the case or simply assist that other agency. The third source is from the public. There are some cases that we may assign to a detective immediately, rather than a patrol officer, because we know the case will eventually be referred to the DCI. These may include Frauds, Sexual Assaults, Identity Theft, and so on.

So what is the volume of work handled by our DCI? In 2020, our police officers responded to over 1,300 calls for service that resulted in over 1,150 police reports being written. Of those 1,150, over 300 were referred to the DCI. And each year, our detectives' clearance rate (cases solved) surpasses the national average.

From television shows, being assigned as a detective may seem like a glamorous position, but our detectives work long hours piecing together complex puzzles. I may be a bit biased, but I can honestly say I have the greatest confidence in our DCI and I am proud of the work they continue to do every day!

History of the Ballwin PD

The Village of Ballwin appointed Fred Rethmeier as its first Marshal on January 5, 1951. After Rethmeier, Marshals were elected to that position. Hermann Baumer was elected Marshal of Ballwin in 1957 which is also when Ballwin became a fourth-class city. Baumer coordinated the purchase and installation of a base radio station and his wife, Lucille, handled the phone calls. Lucille used a porch light to regularly signal Hermann to return to his home at 539 Manchester Road in reference to a call for police assistance. In 1958, the City purchased its first police car, which was shared by Baumer and the four officers who worked part-time in the evenings. In 1959, George Arft was hired as the first full-time police officer.

On April 27, 1964, the City of Ballwin formed a full-time police department appointing Philip St. Onge as the first Chief of Police; he served until 1965. The Department purchased its second marked patrol car that same year. Chief St. Onge resigned in 1965 and Donald "Red" Loehr, a native son and an ex-Cardinal-baseball-player-turned police officer, was appointed as Chief of Police by Mayor Robert Jones. In 1967, a Communications Section was added to the Police Department and four dispatchers were hired. In 1970, the force had 12 uniformed officers and four marked cars. After serving for 35 years, Chief Loehr retired in 1997 and

James Biederman served as police chief until the end of 2007. The Police Department building was named after Chief Loehr in 2002. Steven Schicker served as Chief of Police from March 2008 - December 2015. He was succeeded by Kevin Scott, who was sworn in as Chief of Police and served in that role from April 2016 -August 2019. Doug Schaeffler has been serving as the Ballwin Police Chief since December 9, 2019.

Today, the Department consists of 48 Commissioned Officers, 11 Communications Officers, and an Administrative Clerk who serve the communities of Ballwin and Winchester.

Promotions Retirements

Lorne's dedicated service left a mark on the department and the City, as he served as a Patrol Officer, Detective, Patrol Sergeant, Detective Sergeant, Patrol Lieutenant, Special Operations Lieutenant, and Lieutenant of the Professional Standards Division. He was promoted to Sergeant in 1999, and had served as a Lieutenant since 2004.



Rob Wetzel was promoted to the rank of Lieutenant to fill the spot vacated by Lt. Lorne. Lt. Wetzel has served with the Ballwin Police Department since 1996. Lt. Wetzel is tasked with moving the Department forward with attaining CALEA accreditation in addition to maintaining the Department's Missouri Police Chief's accreditation.

Rob Rogers was promoted to the rank of Sergeant to fill the spot vacated by Lt. Wetzel.

Sgt. Rogers has also served with the Ballwin Police Department since 1996. Sgt. Rogers has been assigned as the supervisor to a patrol squad.

We are thankful for the work Lt. Lorne put in over the past three-plus decades and wish him and his family a happy retirement. We are also proud of the accomplishments of Lt. Wetzel and Sgt. Rogers (pictured below) and look forward to watching them move our department forward in their new roles.



Relay App

This application can be downloaded on any mobile device by scanning the QR code shown below, or by downloading the **Relay: Neighborhood Safety** app from your device's app store.

Relay is a community engagement platform that helps connect first responders with the citizens they serve, creating a space for community protection to thrive. Relay's products create easy avenues to help, report, and communicate in real time, while putting privacy first. Send one-to-one communication for non-emergency incidents to your local law enforcement agency and see trends in the places that matter to you. The goal for this communication tool at Ballwin Days 2021 is to be able to quickly disseminate information to park-goers about a variety of potential safety concerns including weather incidents, missing persons, and any other information that will have an impact on the safety of those attending any portion of Ballwin Days. Ferris Park Project

Our Ferris Park Project is officially complete! New park amenities include .35 miles of trails (including a multi-use pathway), expanded parking lot, redesigned recreation field, and an outdoor fitness structure.

As many of you know, we began construction on this project last October. The decision to update Ferris came after we received input during our Parks Master Plan, in which our community recommended access to the playground from the parking lot, additional parking, and walking trails. Additionally, the Parks Master Plan surveyed our residents, who identified walking/jogging, visiting nature area, and fitness as some of the most important activites in their household. Then in 2019, the City was awarded a grant of \$525,000 to be used for park development, which we put towards implementing these recommendations at Ferris Park.

Our team will continue working hard to provide beautiful community parks for you, your family, and your friends to enjoy. We have plans to update our entire parks system, including Vlasis, Holloway, and New Ballwin, over the next few years. In the meantime, we hope you come and check out our beautifully-updated Ferris Park. Can't wait for you to see it!
