Ballwin Memorial Day Ceremony







The Vlasis Park Master Plan has been crafted in conjunction with the Lawrence Group. After several rounds of community input and changes from the Board of Aldermen, the Department of Parks and Recreation and city staff, this Master Plan was created with YOU in mind!

We want to make sure this park serves the citizens of Ballwin now and well into the future. The Master Plan is a guide to help ensure the space will be maximized for full usage for everyone who wants to enjoy it.

The plan is to redo the park in phases over the next ten years, pending available funding. There are 5 phases (not necessarily in this order):

Playground
Public Works
Great Lawn
Plaza and Pond Rehabilitation
Landscape and Recreation Courts



The central playground is also being transformed. A central staircase and retaining walls will provide links across the different areas of the park. The playground will be updated with new play structures, a splash pad, pavilions for shade, play stages and elevated play.

New greenspace will also be put in around Vlasis Park, including a butterfly garden with local flora and fauna.

This plan has been approved by the Board of Aldermen. It will take some time before any construction or changes will be made to the park, as projects need to be bid out.


This Master Plan is to help guide the direction of the park in the future, and as such, changes could be made as we reach different phases of construction. The City of Ballwin is also in the process of applying for grants to help pay for the park.



Fiber Internet

Two companies have begun installing fiber internet in several places. This will bring faster internet to several parts of Ballwin.

AT&T and i3 have both received right of way excavation permits to do the work. They're required to repair the City's property once the work is completed. The work is happening on the City's property, the right of way (next to the road). There also may be some work in existing utility easements on private property.

Code, Inspections & Permits

A word of warning before hiring someone to do contracted work on your house.

Make sure you read through the entire contract before signing. This contract to the right specifically states that the work is being done WITHOUT permits or inspections from third parties. For many projects, that is illegal and could leave you, the homeowner, with a hefty fine and having to redo all of the work correctly at a major cost.

Chief's Corner



Most people see our officers on the road, patrolling or making a traffic stop. Or even directing traffic around an accident. But most people don't actually know what an officer does during their shift. I mean between the times you see them stopping a car, grabbing a drink at the local gas station, and driving through your neighborhood. So, this article will give you a little taste. I am going to describe to you what an officer did during a recent shift. The shift was a weekend night shift (6 pm to 6 am).

Officer Smith (not their real name) is found sitting in the Patrol Room waiting for shift change. It's about 5:30 pm and he is checking his emails while waiting for roll call. After responding to a few emails he checks CARE, the report writing system, to see if he needs to do some follow-up to previous calls he handled. There are none, for now.

Roll call happens and he learns what sector (of the four) he will be handling and any pertinent information from things that happened during the previous shift. After which he inspects his patrol car (radio, rifle, computer, equipment, car camera, body camera, etc).

Officer Smith pulled off the parking lot and received a call for a traffic accident on Manchester Road. As he arrived, he found it was somewhat minor. He got the road cleared and called for a tow truck for one of the now damaged cars. He spent the next 30 minutes writing the accident report.

Back on the road, he patrolled several businesses to make sure the workers and the customers were safe and that there was nothing out of the ordinary going on in the area.

He then drove into a residential area where he found a car on the street with the trunk open. He pulled over to investigate and simply found that the homeowner forgot to close it after hauling in the groceries.

By now it is 10:00 pm when he and another officer get a call for a domestic disturbance. They respond to find that a young couple has been drinking and are engaged in a pretty intense verbal argument (a neighbor called the cops). The officers worked with the couple and helped one of the two go to their parent's house for the night.

More patrolling followed within the neighborhoods in his sector. As the community is getting ready for bed he is looking for anything unusual. He notes several garage doors open, checks them out, and leaves a note for the homeowner of the situation, with a friendly reminder to check the garage door before going to bed in the future.

Now it is 1:15 am and his radio goes off. Officers in a nearby agency attempted to stop a stolen car but it fled from them. He gets the description and heads to the area where it may be heading. It did not come through Ballwin.

At about 1:30 am, Officer Smith gets a call for a fight outside a local bar. He is one of two officers assigned to the call, but other officers head that way to assist. Upon arrival, they are told that both parties in the fight have left the area. Everyone goes back into service and back to patrolling.

At 3:00 am Officer Smith receives a call for a one-car accident on Big Bend near New Ballwin. The car ran off the road and hit a pole. He arrives and gives aid to the driver. He finds the driver is intoxicated and has a minor injury. Officer Smith calls for an ambulance and a tow truck.

The car gets towed while Officer Smith heads to the hospital in the ambulance with the driver. The driver is attended to by the ER staff. Officer Smith then brings the driver back to the Ballwin Police station where he is booked and put in a holdover cell. The rest of his shift, and a couple of hours into his off-time, will be spent report writing.

By 8:00 am Officer Smith is headed home to get some sleep and then spend time with his family.

Welcome to the life of a Ballwin Police Officer.

School Year Safety

School Resource Officers Reynolds and Schaper are looking forward to being back in the schools again this year. Officer Reynolds has been the SRO for Selvidge Middle School for the last three years, while Officer Schaper is going on her second year for the elementary schools.

Ballwin is the home to six (6) elementary schools and one middle school. SRO Schaper is excited to see the new kindergarten class, and hearing about everyone's summer trips. SRO Reynolds is entering his last year as an SRO. He is looking forward to seeing the growth and maturity of the students.

Both officers wanted to make sure parents and students know the below Safety Tips for the 2023 school year.



SRO School Safety Tips

- 1. Slow Down! Be prepared to stop in or near school zones, residential areas, intersections, and crosswalks for school buses and children walking.
- 2. Parents, please follow the drop off and pick-up maps provided by the schools.
- 3. Practice safe travel habits. Please utilize seatbelts if you are in a vehicle.
- 4. If you plan on walking or riding a bike to school, practice the route with your family. Please utilize sidewalks, crosswalks, and helmets (if you are biking).
 - 5. Bring water!

AED Program

The Ballwin Police Department is constantly evaluating the equipment and training that our officers receive to make a positive impact on the Ballwin community. One area that has been found to be an obvious success is our Automated External Defibrillator (AED) program. According to the University of Pennsylvania, sudden cardiac arrest is a major health problem that affects an estimated 500,000 people every year. When a person suffers a cardiac arrest, their chance of survival decreases by 7% to 10% for each minute that passes without defibrillation. Having AEDs readily available increases the chance of survival for those in need. Our department has responded to and used AEDs on sudden cardiac arrest calls for service numerous times.

Thanks to the generous support of the Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation, the Ballwin Police Department was awarded \$23,246.25 to purchase additional AEDs. An order has been placed for new AEDs and upon their arrival will be deployed in each Ballwin Police patrol vehicle. This additional equipment provides our Officers with the tools they need to help save their lives. We are incredibly grateful to the Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation for their support of our community. First Aid



Ballwin Police Officers go through extensive amounts of training each year.

So far this year officers have spent hours focusing on first aid, trauma kits, Narcan, and CPR. The department was recently approved for a grant, which allowed funding to be spent on new trauma kits.

The trauma kits the officers are carrying could be the difference maker in saving another's life. The same field dressing, gauze,

tourniquets and bandages that were used to help Officer Flamion can be found within these kits.

The officers went through additional training, and for some a refresher, on how to properly use and apply the various life saving items.

Another life saving tool officers now carry is Narcan. With the rise of drug use, and the dangers it can cause, which can be seen across the country, officers did a refresher on Narcan.

In California, there is footage of an officer conducting a traffic stop. The officer observes a white powdery substance, and begins overdosing on the scene. With the quick actions of the supporting officer initiating Narcan, he was able to save the officer's life.


