



REGISTRATION

Wednesday, March 8 is the last day to register to vote in this election. If you wish to vote absentee in this election, more information on this process can be found at www.stlouiscountymo.gov/st-louis-county-government/board-of-elections/ in the Absentee Voting section.

POLLING PLACES

Voters in St. Louis County may vote at any polling place in the County on Election Day. Polling places are open from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Election Day. To find the polling place nearest you, visit www.stlouiscountymo.gov/st-louis-county-government/board-of-elections/ and click on Polling Places.



2023 City Budget

I am pleased to present the City of Ballwin's 2023 Budget. The budget serves as the City's fiscal plan from January 1, 2023 – December 31, 2023. It includes our goals, objectives, and future financial projections. I've included graphs that show the City of Ballwin's projected revenues and expenditures. To view the budget in its entirety, please visit our Budgets page on the City's website. We are committed to making the budgeting process as open and transparent as possible, so please reach out to the City directly if you have any additional questions or concerns.

Total revenues equal \$29,592,424. Major revenue for the City of Ballwin include sales taxes, public utility licenses, and community programs. The City has \$0 property tax, so it's reliant on the categories included in the chart above. This year there is also a transfer in of accumulated fund balance amounting to \$4.4 million.

SALES TAXES represent \$11.7 million or 47% of General and Capital Fund revenues exclusive of transfers. Ballwin consumers pay a sales tax rate of 8.738% of which .5% is for Capital Improvements and .5% is for Parks. An additional 1.0% is distributed from St. Louis County. These revenues are highly variable depending on economic conditions.

PUBLIC UTILITY LICENSES represent \$3.0 million or 12% of General and Capital Fund revenues. A gross receipts tax is paid by both public and private utility companies doing business in Ballwin for use of the public right-of-way and is based on operating revenues. These companies generally pass the tax on to their customers.


COMMUNITY PROGRAMS represent \$3.4 million or 14% of General and Capital Fund revenues. Memberships and fees from Ballwin's community center, golf course and outdoor water park generate these revenues. Additional sources include special programs such as race events, community festivals and facility rentals.

Total expenditures equal \$30,821,893. Police, Public Works, and Capital Improvements make up a significant portion of the City of Ballwin's 2023 Budget.

POLICE represents 32% of the General Fund. Included is the replacement of 3 patrol vehicles, pistols, and 4 additional stationary license plate reader cameras.

PUBLIC WORKS represents 28% of the General Fund and includes road resurfacing, sidewalk repairs and snow and leaf removal. Trimming and removal of trees in the right-of-way is also performed.

CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS total \$8.1 million and represent all expenditures for the Capital Fund. Construction of the new police building, resurfacing of New Ballwin Road and extensive upgrades to Holloway Park are all planned.



Last year, the City of Ballwin was presented with a Distinguished Budget Presentation Award from the Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA) for the 2022 budget. This is the seventh consecutive award for the City. This award certifies Ballwin's budget documents were of the highest quality and rated proficient in serving as: a policy document, a financial plan, an operations guide and a communications device.

The City of Ballwin's budget document consists of its primary General Fund, a Capital Improvements Fund, and several minor funds such as a Sewer Lateral Fund, TDD Fund, and a Federal Asset Seizure Fund. Every fall, each department drafts an estimate of projects and their expenses to present to the Board of Aldermen for consideration, which they then work to solidify and prioritize the remainder of the year.

New Annexations

The City of Ballwin has welcomed two new subdivisions into our city this year!

The Cascades Subdivision and the Charleston Oaks Subdivision petitioned St. Louis County to join the City of Ballwin in 2022. They were both approved in late 2022 by the St. Louis County Boundary Commission and became a part of the City of Ballwin on January 1, 2023.

The Cascades Subdivision brings in 23.3 acres to the City of Ballwin and is located in the Southeast corner of the intersection of Ries Road and Big Bend Boulevard. It contains 43 multi-family housing units and 52 single-family housing units. Cascades residents will join Ward 1.

The Charleston Oaks Subdivision brings in 40 acres to the City of Ballwin and is located in the Southwest corner of the intersection of Ries Road and Big Bend Boulevard. It contains 103 single-family housing units. Charleston Oaks residents will join Ward 4.

Taxes will not increase for current residents of the City of Ballwin as a result of these two annexations.

The City of Ballwin and the Ballwin Police Department strive to provide the best quality and trained officers for the community. The Ballwin Police Department recently upgraded their CAD (Computer Aided Dispatch) system. It is the main tool the officers and dispatchers use to take, respond, and log calls for service. The CAD is a vital piece of equipment for the department.

Ballwin updated their outdated CAD to Premier One. Motorola created Premier One, which will soon be used across all of St. Louis County.

You may wonder why this is important, but this new CAD now allows voice turn by turn directions to calls of service for the officer. In addition to helping the officers know exactly where to go, in the heat of the moment of a hot call or priority call, this addition helps prepare the mindset of the officer to begin to figure out a plan of action. The turn by turn directions allow the officer to remain focused on the call for service.

This CAD was not only implemented in the patrol cars but also in the Ballwin Communications Center for the dispatchers. Their version of the CAD provides more accurate GPS coordinates for officer's location. It also provides audible and visual alarms for status checks on the officers while they are on a call. That can be one of a dispatcher's biggest worries day in: officer location and safety. This CAD provides these features which not only benefit the dispatchers but the officers as well.



One of the biggest features of this CAD system is the ability to integrate with other departments across St. Louis County. That's incredibly important for coordination, especially if there was a mass-causality event like a tornado, earthquake, or fire in the area. That would allow dispatchers from other communication centers to jump in and easily assist and help out the respected area that is in need. The CAD is more user friendly, which makes it easier to enter calls in the midst of ringing phones, officers talking on the radio, and while listening to the person on the other line. The CAD is perfect to use in a high paced environment.



The new software system was paid for out of the City of Ballwin's Police Dispatch budget. It has been planned for several years, and was finally implemented in the Fall of 2022.



Chief's Corner



Recently I attended the graduation of the latest class of police officers from the St Louis County & Municipal Police Academy. I had the honor of being the keynote speaker, something I have wanted to do for some time.

The graduation was well attended. Each graduating recruit had quite a few friends and family on hand to celebrate their accomplishment. And it is a great accomplishment. Six months of classroom instruction, physical training, firearms, emergency response driving, etc.

They were each stepping into a career that will include working rotating shifts, working holidays, and missing family events. A lifetime of being under appreciated and overworked. This begs the question, "Why would anyone do this job"? The answer is simple: it is an amazing job. In my eyes, there is no better job on the planet. Every day, a police officer gets the opportunity to meet great and interesting people, to serve people who truly need help, and to save lives. Police officers encounter people on their worst day, and help them through it so they can eventually get to their best day.

During my speech at the graduation I mentioned these things. And then I told them a story of something that happened just recently. One of my officers was eating at a local restaurant when a young lady (mid-20's) approached him and asked if he remembered her. He did not.

She said she was going to pay for his lunch that day because of something he had done for her about a dozen years prior. She reminded him of that day when she was 13 years old and had come home from school to the house where she and her mom lived. She found her mom on the floor. Her mom had passed away while she was at school. She called 9-1-1 and he was the officer who was sent to her house. He hugged her. Contacted other family members and took care of her until they arrived. And she never forgot his kindness.

I told this story to the graduates to tell them this: they are beginning a great career with great opportunities. And at the end of that career they will have a legacy. A legacy that will live in the hearts and memories of all those they have encountered and helped throughout their decades of service.

Citizens Police Academy

The Ballwin Police Department and the Ellisville Police Department held their first joint Citizens Police Academy this year since 2017-2018.

A lot has changed since the last academy, and the Ballwin Police Department, along with Chief Schaeffler, was eager to revitalize some community programs. One of the goals set by the community affairs unit this year was to bring this important program back, as it is a huge building block for the department and the community we serve. The interactions with the officers and lesson plans allow citizens a chance to learn, understand, and get a glimpse into what police go through and need to know.







This class consisted of fifteen citizens, a wide age group, and diverse backgrounds. For ten weeks, the citizens put their trust in instructors (officers) to teach them the ways of law enforcement. The citizens learned things from Constitutional Law, to common policies, to traffic stop procedures, to traffic crashes, DWI and Field Sobriety Test, how various equipment and computer applications work, firearms safety, and much more.

They had a chance to utilize what they had learned during the "role play" week and try to impress the officers with some new found knowledge. While many will go back and enjoy retirement or their full time job, some have shown a deeper interest into the field and may contemplate a career switch.
