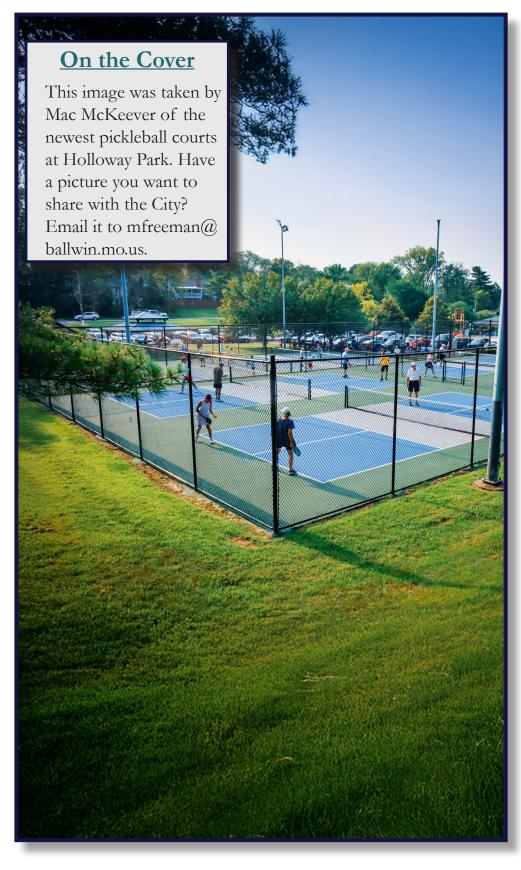

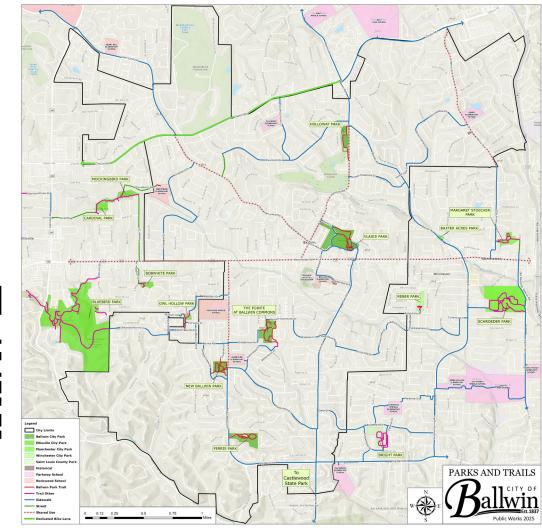
Key Trail Connections:

Chief's Corner

As we approach the Summer months, I want to let you know how you may do your part in keeping Ballwin one of the safest cities in America. The Ballwin Police Department is unable to do it alone. We need you to make sure you put your garage doors down at night. Thieves know the garage is the location of the jackpot for power tools, sporting goods equipment and alcohol (the good old refrigerator in the garage). While we are talking about your garage, make sure you bring your valuables and lock up your vehicles parked in the driveway or on the street. You may sign up for a 9 PM Reminder Text Message on the City of Ballwin's Textcaster sign-up page using the link below.



Please call us if you see something suspicious. You know your neighborhood and what is normal. You are not bothering us, if you call to report a suspicious car, or person, you see while out walking the dog. We would rather receive a call for something suspicious occurring at 3 AM than to respond at 8 AM to a theft report. You may dial 911 if you see a crime in progress, or you may call our dispatch center at (636) 227-2941 or 2951 if you want us to check out a suspicious vehicle or person.

Local outdoor swimming pools will be opening over Memorial Day weekend. When visiting pools, remember to bring only the items that are necessary (bring only the cash needed for the pool). Make sure to use a locker and lock it. Thieves will enter a locker room and check to see if anyone placed items in a locker without locking it. Try to keep your personal items on you. Do not leave anything laying around on the pool deck. If you have to leave something laying around, do your best to hide it. Thieves will be less tempted if an item is out of sight.

I want to let you know about another service we provide to residents. We will check your residence while you are on vacation, or away from your home. Requests up to three weeks in duration will be checked daily. Requests for security checks over three weeks, will be checked biweekly. You may sign up for a vacation check at the link below.

Fire Departments throughout Ballwin like Metro West Fire Protection Diwstrict, West County EMS & Fire Protection District and the Monarch Fire Protection District provide enhanced emergency response to the City of Ballwin through PulsePoint, empowering CPR-trained citizens to assist in sudden cardiac arrest (SCA) emergencies.

How PulsePoint Works:

- Real-Time Alerts: The free PulsePoint app notifies users when someone nearby is experiencing SCA in a public place.
- AED Locations: The app directs bystanders to the nearest automated external defibrillator (AED) for immediate assistance.
- Community Awareness: Stay informed about fires, accidents, and other emergencies in Ballwin.

Every second counts—immediate CPR can double or triple survival rates. Download the PulsePoint app today from the App Store or Google Play and help save lives.

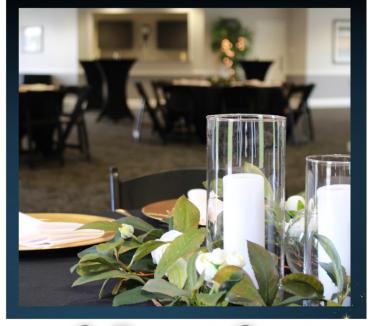
