





Where does my property tax go?

Did you know that the City of Ballwin has not charged property taxes for nearly 40 years? That may be surprising to hear since property owners still have to pay property taxes to other numerous political districts that serve the City of Ballwin. See the example for 2025 property tax rates on a \$400,000 appraised house value, the average price of a home in Ballwin. We've used the Rockwood School District & Metro West Fire Protection District tax rates as examples, but the City of Ballwin is also served by the Parkway School District and West County EMS & Fire Protection District as well as the Monarch Fire Protection District.



Leaf Pickup



The Ballwin Public Works Department is excited to continue our free residential curbside leaf collection program this fall! This program began on October 27th and will run through the first week of December.

Here are some friendly reminders to help get you and your yard ready for leaf pickup day. For more information, please visit our website.

- There will be at least one crew assigned to each ward (1,2,3 and 4).
- If you're unsure what ward you live in, use the QR Code to the left.
- Crews will collect leaves Monday through Friday and will begin each
- day where they ended the day before. You can expect at least 4 passes
- through your neighborhood.
- If you'd prefer not to wait on our crews, Republic Services will pick up your bagged leaves as part of their yard waste disposal.
- We have created a Master Street List by ward, which is updated every afternoon to help you track crews progress throughout the City. This can be accessed on the Curbside Leaf Collection page under the Public Works section on our
- website.
- Please rake your leaves to the edge of your property next to the street. Do not pile the leaves up in the street or gutter.
- Do not park on top, or in front of leaf piles.
- This program may be delayed, halted, or ended due to weather conditions,
- manpower issues, heightened leaf volume, equipment down time, etc.
- There will be no pickup on City-observed holidays (Nov. 27, Nov. 28, Dec. 24, Dec. 25)
- Leaves will NOT be collected from any multi-family units such as apartments,
- condominiums, or villas.
- Leaves will NOT be collected along private streets within any multi-family
- complexes or any commercial, school, institutions, or non-City governmental properties.

Chief's Corner

As we approach the holiday season, I'd like to ask for your help in reducing crime in our community. While we gather to celebrate, thieves are often looking for opportunities to spoil our festivities. When shopping at local stores, stay aware of your surroundings as you walk to and from your vehicle. Park in well-lit areas, keep your vehicle locked, and avoid leaving gifts inside. If you must store items in your car, make sure they are out of sight. Thieves often watch parking lots for people who place valuables in their cars before heading back inside.



If you plan to travel during the holiday season, consider placing lights on timers to make your home look occupied. You may also request a vacation check from the police department if you'll be away for several days—just use the QR code to the right or call us at 636-227-9636. Have your mail held by the post office or ask a trusted neighbor to collect it daily. And remember, wait until you return home before posting vacation photos on social media.

To help prevent package thefts—or "porch piracy"—arrange for deliveries to a location where someone can accept them. If that's not possible, request that packages be placed in a secure spot on your property. Some garage door openers even allow you to assign a temporary access code so delivery drivers can place items safely inside.

After the holidays, don't advertise new purchases to thieves. Break down boxes from large items like televisions so they aren't visible in your trash. If possible, dispose of packaging at your workplace or another location that permits it. Finally, keep an eye out for your neighbors. If you notice anything suspicious in your neighborhood, please call our non-emergency number at 636-227-2941. If you need us, we're here for you.

As many of our neighbors trade winter chills for sunny skies, we know leaving home comes with a bit of unease—especially when you're splitting your time between two places. That's where the Ballwin Police Department's Vacation Check Program steps in to bring you peace of mind.

You'll be asked to provide:

Your trip dates

Alarm system or security camera information

Whether lights will be on or off

Vehicles left on the property

Whether anyone else will have access or stay at the home

Emergency contact info



The combination of cold weather, shorter days, and a general sense of gloom can contribute to what many describe as "winter blues." The body's natural rhythms, influenced by sunlight, can be disrupted during the darker months, leading to a dip in mood, energy, and motivation. For those already struggling with mental health conditions such as anxiety, depression, or bipolar disorder, winter's toll can be especially hard. The isolation often experienced in the colder months can also exacerbate feelings of loneliness and hopelessness.

The Ballwin Police Department has taken significant steps to address mental health concerns in the community. With nearly 95% of its staff certified through the Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) program, Ballwin PD stands at the forefront of integrating mental health awareness into law enforcement. This program, designed to teach officers de-escalation techniques and provide an understanding of mental illnesses, has been a key factor in helping those in crisis.

CIT-certified officers are trained to recognize the signs and symptoms of various mental health disorders. Instead of relying solely on traditional law enforcement tactics, these officers are equipped to approach situations with empathy and an understanding of what someone might be experiencing. Whether it's someone dealing with seasonal depression, anxiety, or more complex issues, CIT officers know how to engage in ways that prioritize safety, compassion, and the appropriate mental health resources.

Ballwin PD works closely with a network of local mental health organizations to ensure that people in crisis receive the help they need. Through these partnerships, officers can connect individuals with the right services and support systems. A community mental health liaison further ensures that follow-up care is provided, and if necessary, officers can work with the person and their family to develop a comprehensive plan for ongoing care.

If you or someone you know is struggling with mental health challenges, it's important to remember that support is available. Seasonal depression, anxiety, bipolar disorder, and other mental health conditions don't have to be faced alone. Whether it's reaching out to the Ballwin Police Department or connecting with one of the many mental health organizations they work with, there are numerous resources ready to help.
