Subject: Replacement of Totaled Detective Vehicle

Tom:

On July 2, 2015 Detective Michael Reynolds, while working, was operating the 2014 black Chevrolet Impala assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division. He was stopped at the electric signal on Manchester Road and Manchester Meadows Drive at which time his vehicle was struck from the rear by a motorist. The impact forced Detective Reynolds' vehicle into the vehicle which was stopped in front of him.

The vehicle has extensive body damage and a bent frame. Our insurance company totaled the vehicle, which has 18,827 miles on it. I am requesting to replace the vehicle with a 2016 Chevrolet Impala off of the MoDOT State Bid at a price of \$17,832.00. Don Brown Chevrolet holds the state contract and will need to order the replacement vehicle.

The insurance settlement is \$16,125.25 and the difference in the purchase price will be off-set by Drug Asset Forfeiture Funds. I am requesting Board approval to replace the vehicle assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division.

Detective Reynolds was injured in the accident. The driver of the vehicle which struck Detective Reynolds' vehicle was arrested for Driving While Intoxicated and Leaving the Scene of an Accident.
