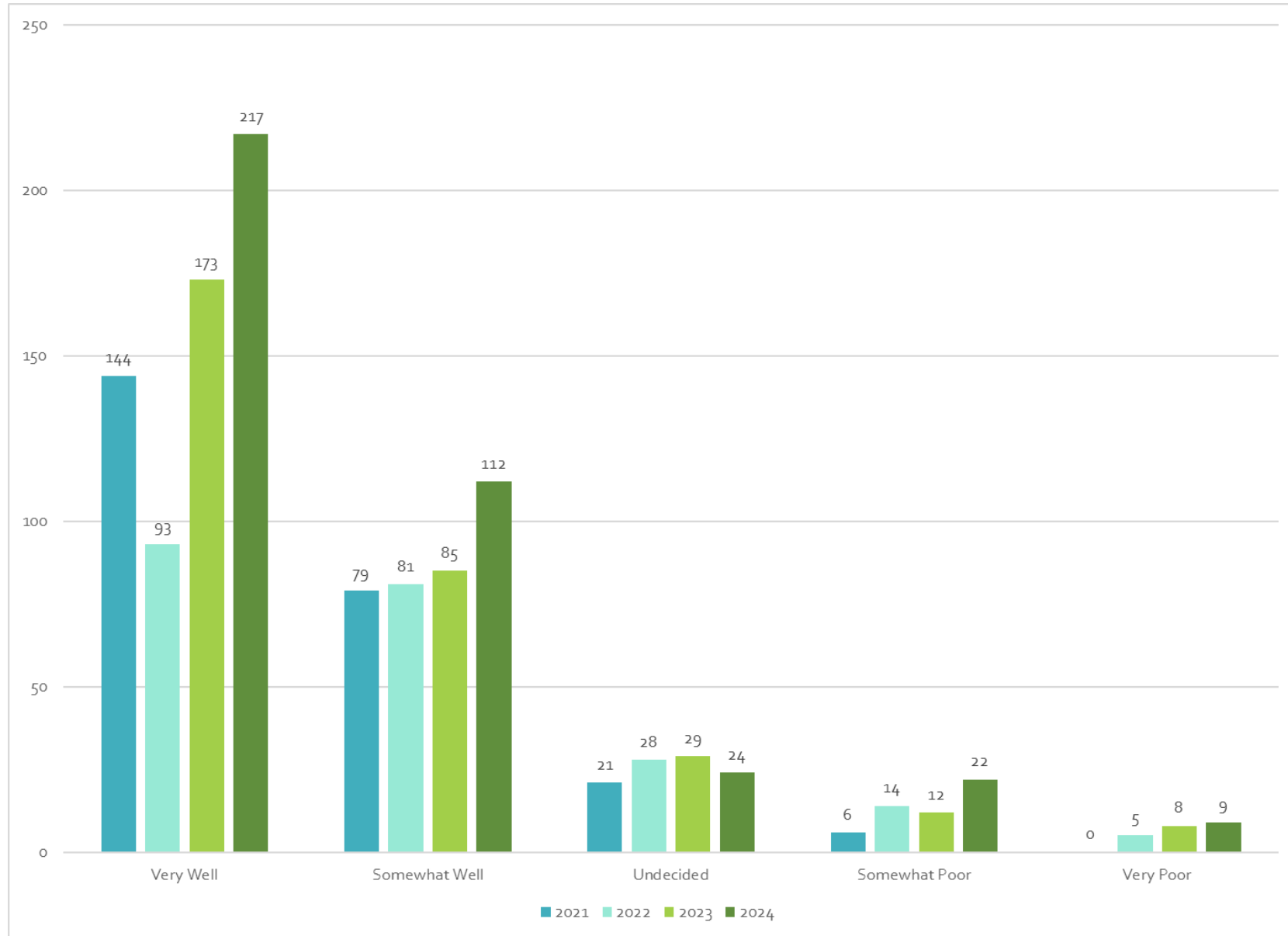

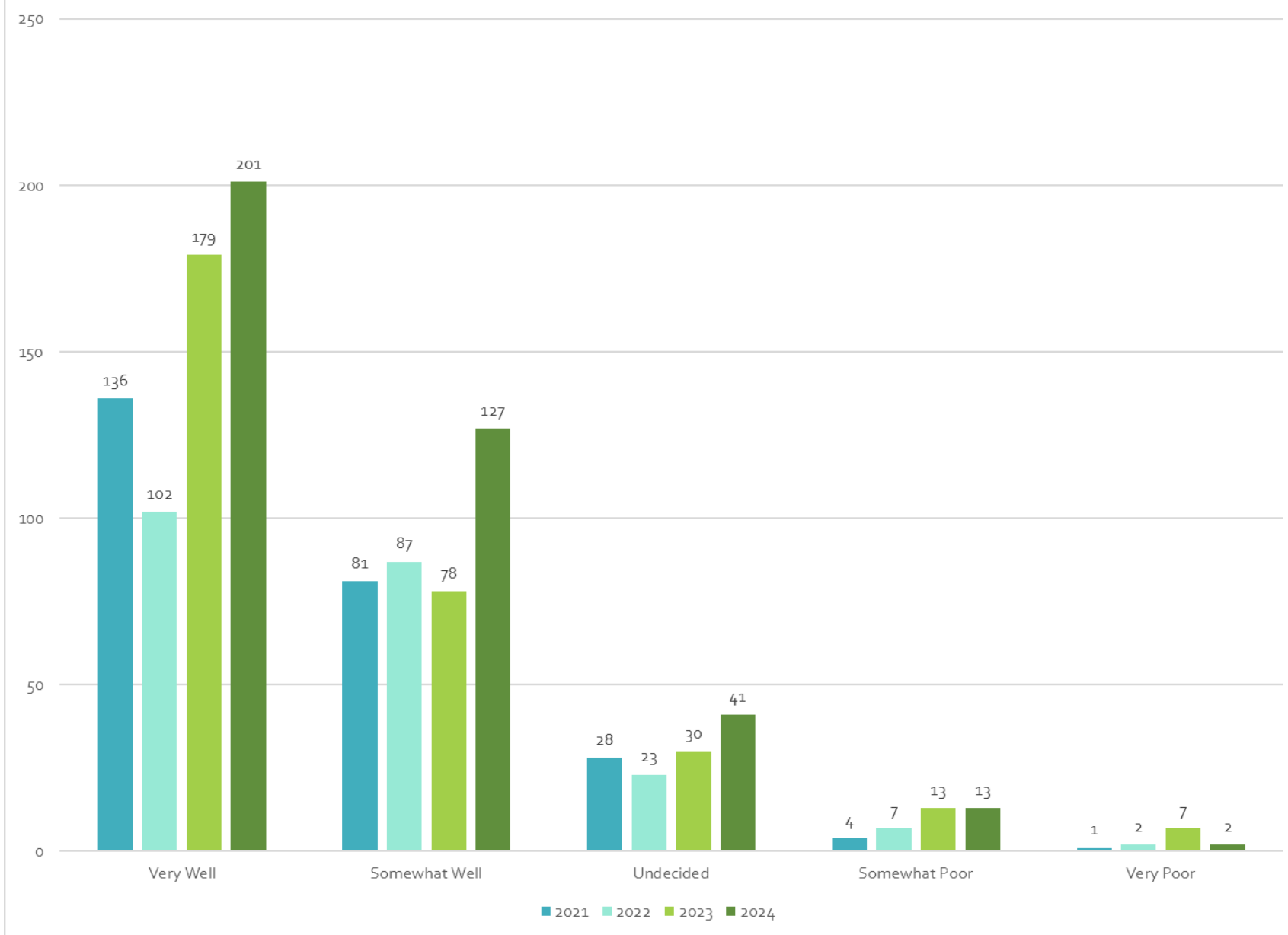

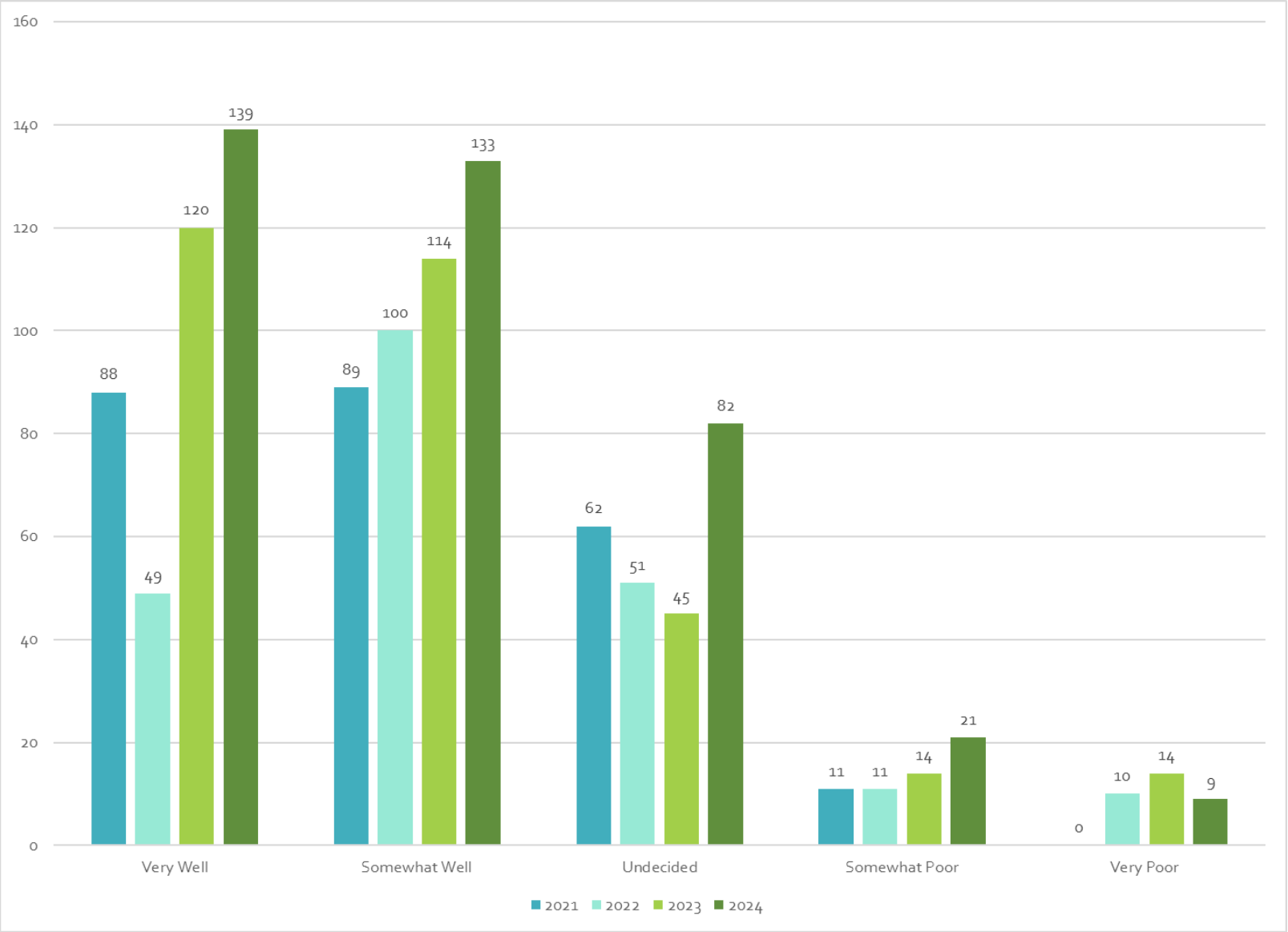

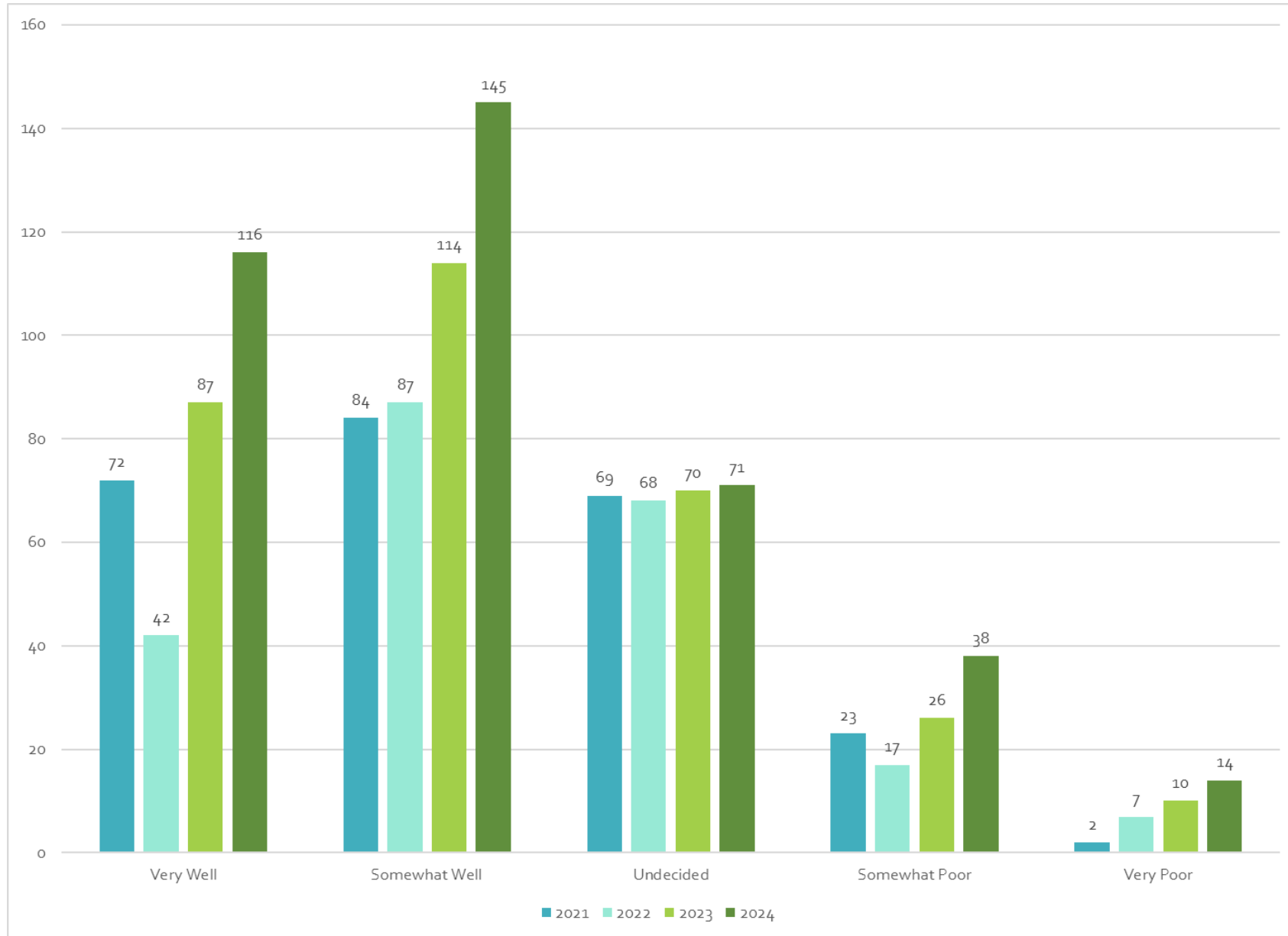

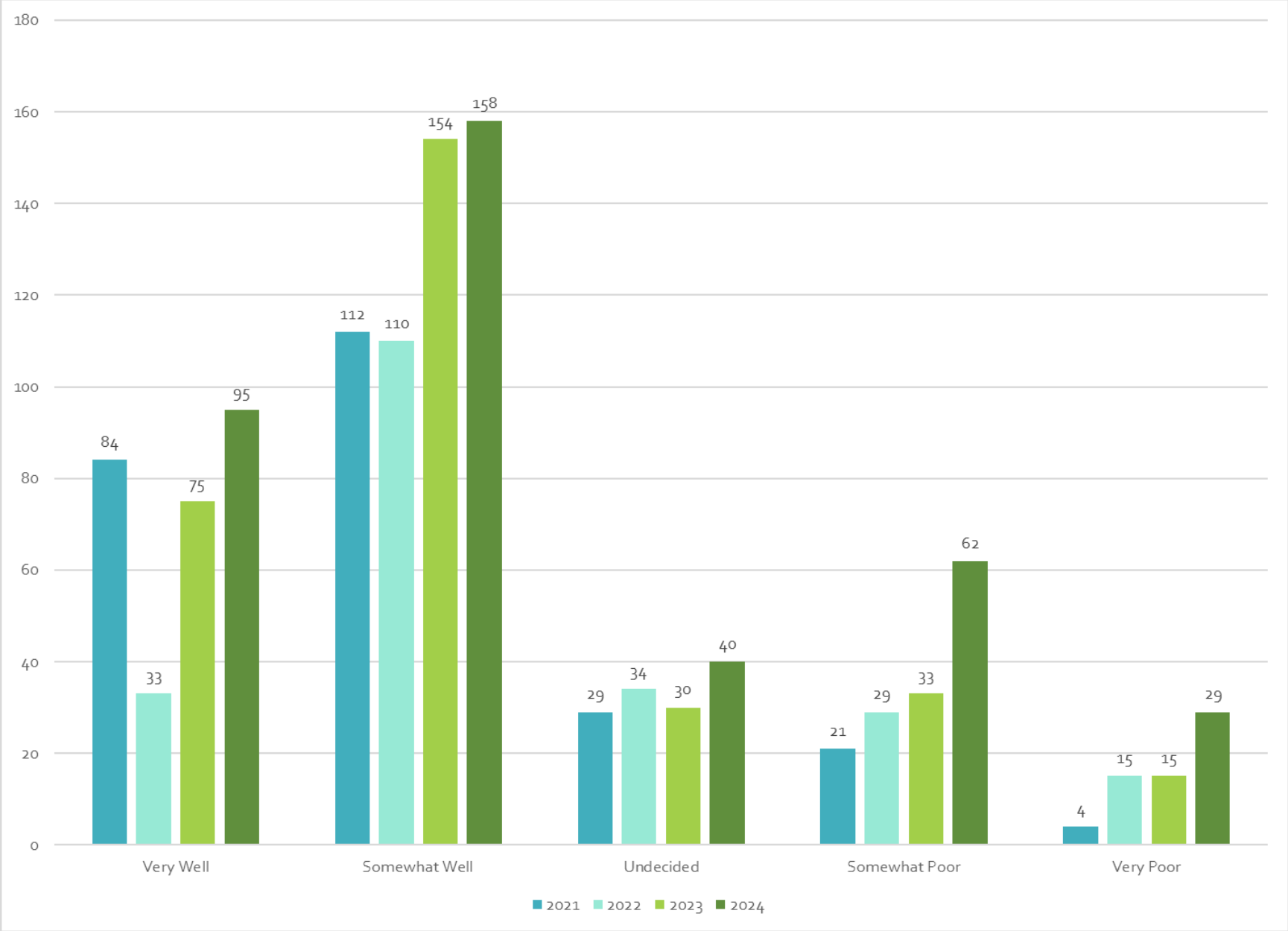

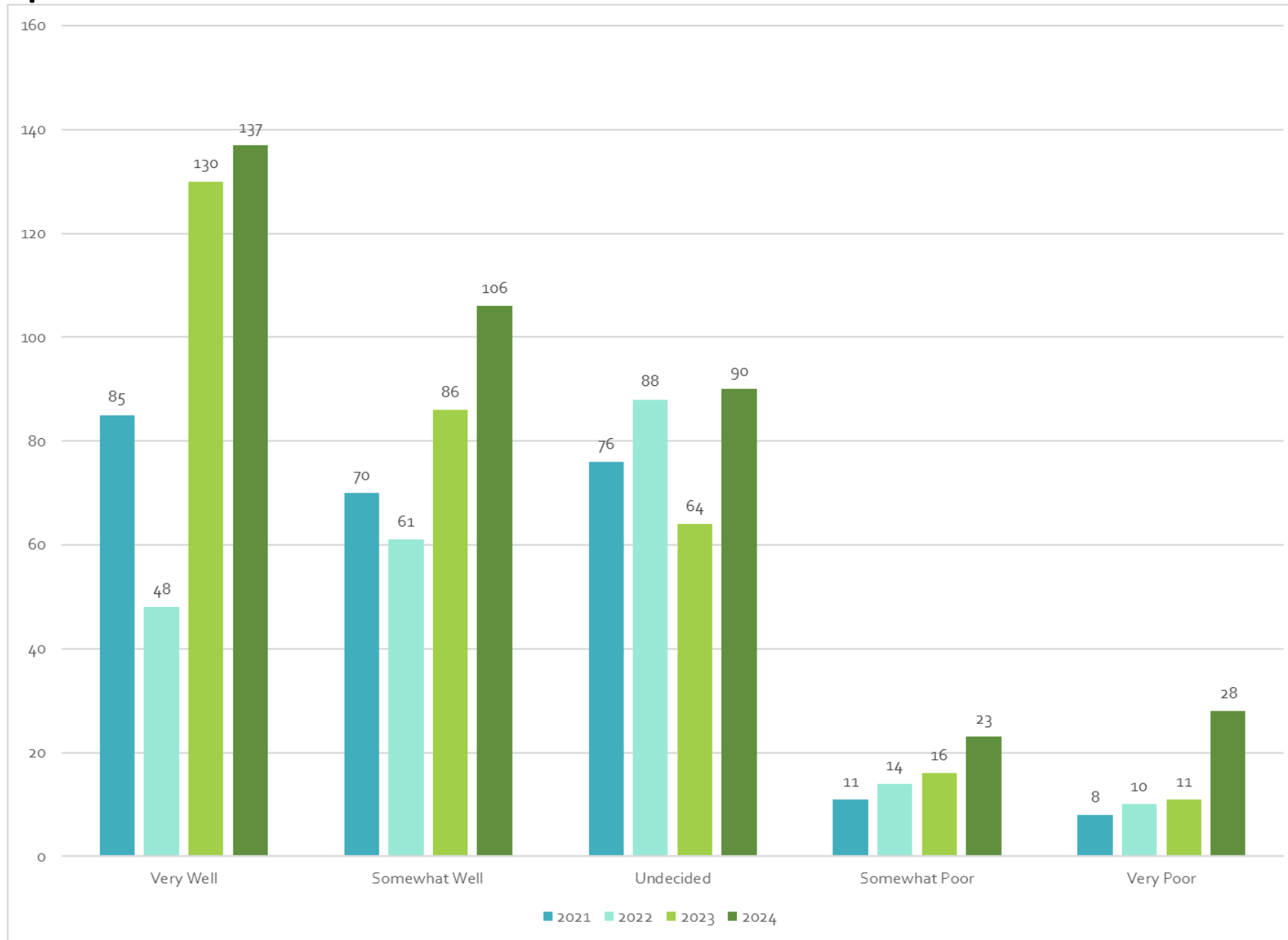
Tree Maintenance in Rights-of-Way



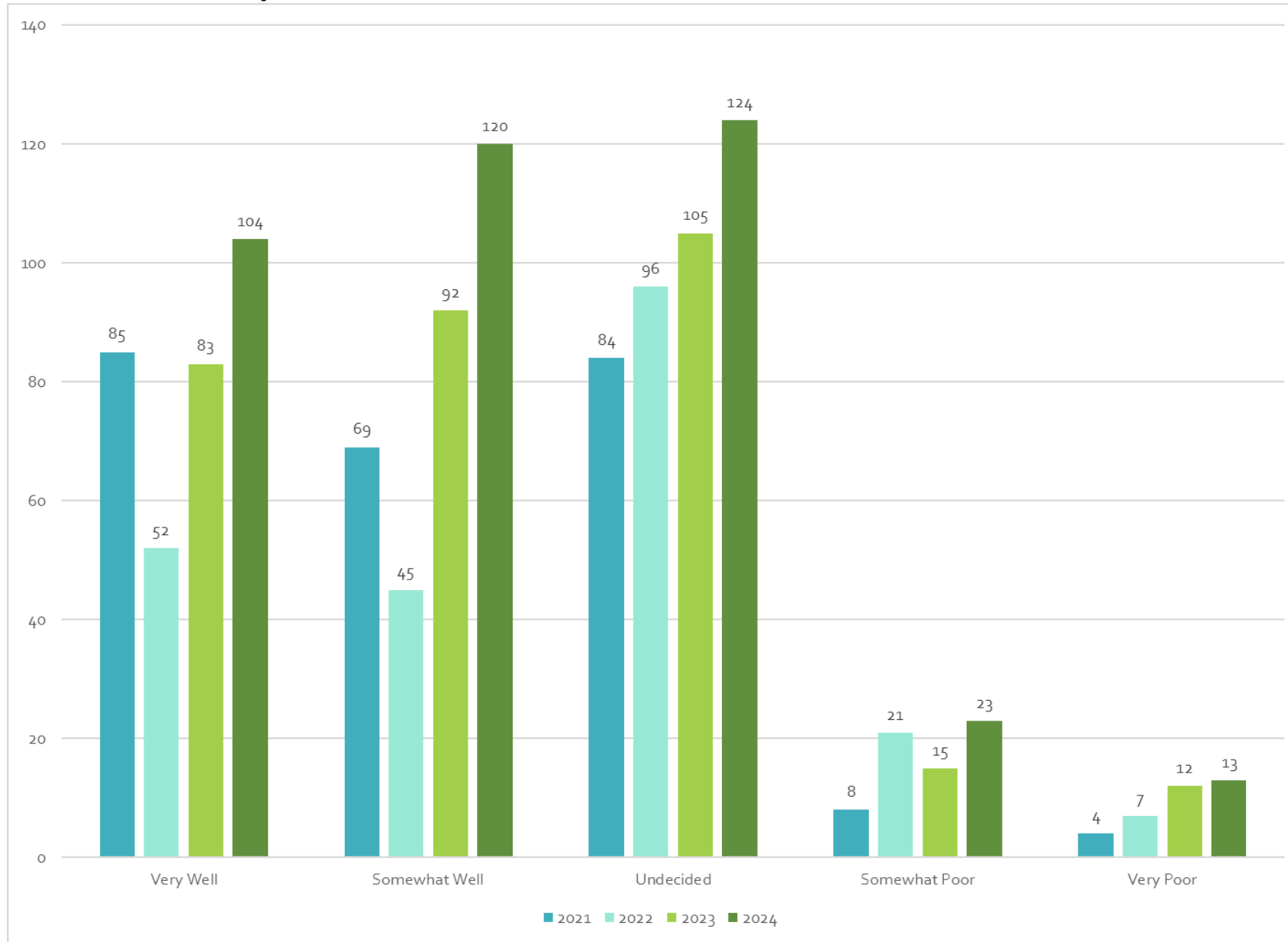

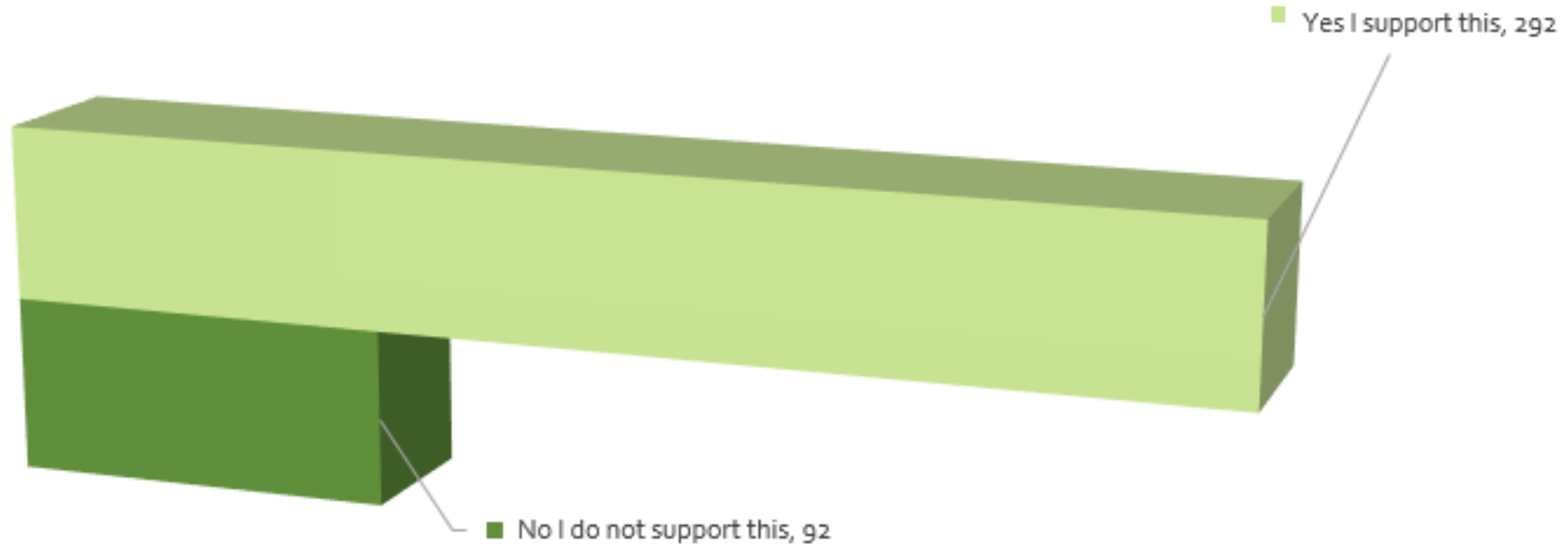
