RE: Authorization to Sell Equipment

Department/Program: Public Works/Support

Recommendation: Staff recommends selling a Redi Haul Flatbed Trailer, a 2009 Bobcat T-190 and a 1998 GMC Topkick on Gov Deals.com.

Explanation:

The trailer was an older parks trailer which would need repairs to keep in service. We recommend selling rather than repair.

The 2009 Bobcat T-190 was in use in the parks department and recently traded out with a unit from the street dept. The T-190 needs major repairs as metal shavings were found in the hydraulic drive motors and filters. Bobcat of St. Louis has offered us \$4000 for the unit on trade. But we would like to try to get a higher price on Gov Deals. We will set the minimum for \$4000, in the event we receive no bids, we would like to sell to Bobcat of St. Louis on trade.

The 1998 GMC topkick is the old sweeper chassis which only had a certificate of origin. The sweeper was never titled. Staff has tried to obtain a title, but the fees and the process in which to get a title exceed the value of the vehicle. We recommend selling the vehicle "as is" with the certificates of origin.
