RE: Asphalt Milling

Department/Program: Public Works- Streets and Sidewalks

RECOMMENDATION: We recommend awarding this contract to the low bidder, GS Grinding Services

EXPLANATION: For many years we have contracted for the asphalt milling and repaving of streets. With the purchase of an asphalt paver in 2017, the paving budgeted in 2019 will be completed in-house.

Request for bid notices were sent to three contractors and advertised in the St. Louis Business Journal, Construction Market Data, Dodge Data & Analytics, and on the City's website.

The table below summarizes the bids received on May 19, 2019.
