

# CONSENT ITEMS

**RE:** ROJEAN DRIVE RECONSTRUCTION

**DEPARTMENT:** PUBLIC WORKS

**PROGRAM:** PAVEMENT

**RECOMMENDATION:** Join with the City of Ellisville in awarding the contract for the reconstruction of Rojean Drive to the low bidder, L. Krupp Construction, with Ballwin's cost limited to \$70,000.

**EXPLANATION:** In 2011 the cities of Ellisville and Ballwin agreed to reconstruct Rojean Drive as a joint project. Rojean lacks curbs and underground storm sewers. Ellisville agreed to be lead agency since the majority of the street is within Ellisville. The project length is 1,338.06 with 228 feet of this length within Ballwin. On July 12, 2013, Ellisville received and opened two bids. As reported in Ellisville's attached email dated July 12, 2013, the bids received are as follows:

L. Krupp Construction	\$293,610.95
Kelpe Contracting, Inc.	\$296,937.23

Ballwin's portion of the cost is limited to \$70,000. Both contractors have done satisfactory work for Ballwin in the past.
