## **CONSENT ITEM**

**RE:** SLAB AND SIDEWALKS

**DEPARTMENT:** PUBLIC WORKS

**PROGRAM:** PAVEMENT AND SIDEWALKS

**RECOMMENDATION:** We recommend awarding this unit price contract to the low bidder, M&H Concrete Contractors, Inc.

**EXPLANATION:** The 2015 budget provides for mill/repave of asphalt surfaced streets, slabs on exposed concrete streets, and sidewalk replacement and upgrading of curb ramps to current ADA standards. Mill/repave consists of two separate bids and contracts. One for existing asphalt removal (milling) and slab replacement. The other contract is for placement of a new asphalt surface (refer to asphalt overlay memorandum).

Request for bid notices were sent to 13 contractors and advertised in the St. Louis Business Journal, Reed Construction Data, Construction Market Data, FW Dodge Reports, and on the City's website. Bid specifications are on file at the Public Works Department.

On January 23, 2015, bids were received for asphalt overlay removal (milling), concrete pavement slab replacement, sidewalk replacement to eliminate tripping hazards, and upgrading curb ramps to current ADA standards. Table 1 summarizes the six (6) bids received and opened.
