RE: Vlasis Park Electric

An invitation to bid was once again advertised to provide improved electrical service for Ballwin Days and other city sponsored special events along with the installation of two new light fixtures in the Police Department parking lot to match other park fixtures. The request for proposal included two projects and two alternates.

Project A: Run electric from comfort station to four electrical vaults to be installed around perimeter of upper parking lot.

Project B: Run electric from tennis courts to two vaults to be installed along block wall in plaza area.

Alternate 1: To include an additional conduit for speaker wire when running special event electric service.

Alternate 2: Provide and install two new parking lot lights to match other fixtures in park.

Attached are the bid results. Total budget to complete all of the electrical work is \$38,000. Total price from the low bidder, Vision Electric, to complete just the special event wiring is \$33,200 compared with \$26,000 when the project was bid earlier this year.

Because the project was bid in pieces the city could select all or a portion of the work. It would be beneficial to do at least a portion of the special event wiring but because this bid came in higher than the last time it was bid my recommendation is to reject both bids.
