Camp FAQs

Is Ballwin Day Camp an Outdoor Camp? Yes, Ballwin Day Camp is held outside. Camp will make arrangements for inclement weather, excessive heat, etc. All changes for drop-off/pick-up and camp location changes will be communicated through our ePACT system (see page 6).

What should I bring to camp? All campers MUST bring a lunch, snack, water bottle, sunscreen, a swimsuit, a towel and must wear closed-toed shoes. On Fridays, the Kona Ice Food Truck will be available to campers at the Pointe, so bring money if you'd like to participate.

Can I find info about camp online? Yes. Visit the City of Ballwin's website at www.ballwin.mo.us/summercamps/ to register online and find camp information, dates, times, cost, and an online version of this guide.

Do all campers have to be potty trained? Yes, all campers are required to be fully potty trained before beginning camp.

What do campers do for lunch? All campers must bring a non-perishable lunch daily, including a morning snack and drink. This is an outdoor camp, so package it appropriately to ensure the heat does not affect the food. No glass permitted.

How will I know what group my camper is in? We will be dividing groups by age: 5-6, 7-8, 9-10 and 11-14. Signs will be displayed at check in to direct campers to their age-specific group.

Does my child need to complete Kindergarten prior to camp? Yes, all 5-year-olds must have already completed a year of Kindergarten in order to register for camp.

What is the camper to counselor ratio? To ensure all children are properly supervised we maintain a camper to counselor ratio of 8:1 for campers age 5-6 and 9:1 for campers age 7-14.

My child wants to purchase something from the North Pointe concession stand, do I need to send cash? You can load a key fob with "Ballwin Bucks." This is a great alternative to cash and can be purchased at The Pointe or North Pointe.

Who do I contact if:

There is an issue with registration, I need a refund, or to transfer a registration? For all registration issues please contact the Camp Director at campdirector@ballwin.mo.us or 636.227.8950.

I need to add someone to a pick up list, speak with the Camp Director, or arrange a late drop-off or early pick-up. For all day-to-day issues, ePACT will be used for pick-up list updates, direct communication with the Camp Director/Assistant Director. For emergencies, please use the Camp Cell Phone at 314.581.2806 - available each day of camp between 7 a.m. - 6 p.m.

I need to speak to someone about medication, disability, or securing an inclusion support staff. For all questions related to inclusion services please contact Inclusive Recreation Coordinator Terri Johnson at tjohnson@desperesmo.org or 314.835.6157.

Get Registered

Registration for the 2026 Ballwin Summer Camps opens on Sunday, February 1, 2026 at 7 a.m online and in person at the Pointe for VIP and/or Residents ONLY. All others are open to register Sunday, February 15, 2026.

Space is limited and camps fill up quickly. Sign up early to secure your child's place, as there is no guarantee those waitlisted will be accepted. Registration closes at noon the Monday before camp starts.

*Club AM is NOT offered for Aqua Camp, Junior Lifeguard Camp or Water Polo Camp.

Refund Requests

1. Full Refund: A full refund will be provided if we cancel a program.

2. Medical Prorated Refund: Registrants who cancel due to health reasons are eligible for a prorated refund, minus a \$10 processing fee. A doctor's note or healthcare confirmation letter is required.

3. Cancellation or Transfer Fee: A \$20 fee will be charged for camp cancellations or transfers per camper, per week of camp. All requests must be submitted at least one week prior to the camp start date. **No refunds will be given for cancellations or transfers requested within one week of the camp start date.**

4. How to Request: All cancellation or transfer requests must be submitted in writing or via email to the Camp Director at campdirector@ballwin.mo.us.

Inclement Weather

As Ballwin Summer Camp is an outdoor program, if weather conditions require, activities will be moved indoors to The Pointe or The Ballwin Golf Course. In the case of high temperatures, camp will adjust to a schedule of lighter activities and water games. Parents will be notified via ePACT.

Drop Off/Pick Up

Please ensure your camper has their lunch, water bottle, appropriate shoes, clothing, and sunscreen. Since our camps serve a wide range of ages, campers will be divided into smaller groups based on age. Counselors will greet you in the morning to check in your child and place them in their group.

When registering, you'll be asked to list individuals authorized to pick up your camper at the end of the day. For safety reasons, campers will only be released to those on the approved pick-up list. *ePact will be used for all pick-up and drop-off and approved pick-up lists.

Weekly Newsletter

A weekly newsletter will be sent by email every Wednesday before camp begins. The newsletter will contain schedules and important information for the upcoming week of camp. The newsletter will also be posted on the Camp website at ballwin.mo.us/summercamps/ each Wednesday for those that may not receive an email.



Why are we using ePACT?

- To save you time - With ePACT, you only need to complete your child's information once and update it as needed.
- Reduces risks associated with HIPAA - Collecting data electronically.
- Checking campers in/out using contactless methods reduces contact.
- For better security & privacy- ePACT's high encryption levels and commitment to security means your data on ePACT is safer than on paper.

How it Works:

- Register for Camp with Ballwin Parks and Recreation - without all the tedious questions.
- You'll receive an email invite from ePact to share information with Ballwin Parks and Recreation.
- Click 'Complete Request' to create a free account, or log-in if you already have an existing ePACT account.
- Enter the required information, like medical conditions, allergies, ADA accommodations, and lifejacket requirements so that program staff have access.

It's a very simple process! ePACT will send a request for EACH child - click the "Complete Request" button, create an account and follow the prompts to share data with Ballwin Parks and Recreation. If you have more than one child attending, family data will automatically pre-fill, saving you time!

****Please note ePACT is a different system than the system you used to register your child for camp, your login information for Ballwin Parks and Recreation Registration (RecTrac) will not automatically log into ePACT****

Additional Perks:

- Check in/out at the touch of a button. You have the power to add/remove authorized pickup individuals within your account. Grandma in town to do a surprise pickup? Simply add her to the authorized pickup list and include her picture.
- Global and direct communication - With ePACT we can communicate with all parents, specific age groups, or individual parents/emergency contacts with ease. Communication can come via text, email, and automated voicemail all at once.
- The power to update information - You have the ability to update information throughout the camp season. New meds for your camper? Simply update your camper's ePACT account. Your camper took swimming lessons and can now swim independently and no longer requires a lifejacket? Just update the camper's ePACT account.

Weekly Camps

Day Camp Ages 5-10 - Max Capacity 150

Get Ready for a Fun Summer!

Day Camps meet every week throughout the summer and feature different activities and field trips each week. Campers are divided into age groups and participate in games, crafts, activities, and swimming. All drop off and pick ups are done at the Playground at The Pointe at Ballwin Commons, except Thursdays which will be at Holloway Park Playground at the entrance to The North Pointe Aquatic Center. Parents are required to walk their campers to the drop-off locations and check them in with the counselors. Only authorized individuals are allowed to pick up campers. Campers will swim or play water games at The Pointe and Thursday at North Pointe, so make sure to bring a swimsuit and a towel. Club AM & PM are available to add on to any week of Day Camps.

*Indoor pool is scheduled for renovations during Summer 2026. Camp will accommodate water games for pool use during closure.

This is a perfect way to spend your summer: outside, active, and in the water! Aqua Campers are especially encouraged to bring plenty of sunscreen and water (sunscreen will not be provided by camp). Campers will participate in organized activities prior to lunch. When North Pointe opens, campers will have the freedom to swim in the pools available during the day or may spend time under the pavilion hanging out with friends.

*Please note, Aqua Camp is **NOT** a substitute for swim lessons. Campers are required to be able to swim 25 yards unassisted and tread water for 2 minutes. If a camper does not meet the minimum swimming requirements, they will be transferred to Day Camp or Teen Camp with a \$15 transfer fee charged. Additionally, there is **no Club AM** available for Aqua Camp.
